A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, May 10, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Patrick Call, Chair; Ann English, Vice-Chairman; Richard Searle, Supervisor; Michael Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Britt Hanson, Chief Civil Deputy Attorney; and Katie Howard, Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Call called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2010 CATERPILLAR MODEL 140M MOTOR GRADER FROM EMPIRE MACHINERY COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$289,716.89 INCLUDING SALES TAX IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS, CONDITIONS AND PRICING OF INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB) NO. 10-45-HFM-04.

Supervisor Searle asked that this item be removed from consent.

Supervisor Searle stated that he requested this be removed from consent because he thought we had purchased the only grader that we were going to, earlier this year. He continued that times are tough and we are keeping our machines updated; discussed previously the idea of keeping our machines in service longer. On heavier machines, warranty runs out at approximately 6,000 hours. He thinks keeping machines in service to 10,000 hours is a good idea and is not comfortable spending \$280,000 right now. Machines are not being maintained the way they should be because we do not have enough people.

Mr. Ortega gave the Board two sheets to describe the financial impact. He understands Supervisor Searle's concerns. One strategy is to keep the graders longer. He directed the Board's attention to the blue tier on chart. If we look at keeping one or both of those graders the trade-in value goes down \$6,000-\$10,000 per machine, per year.

Supervisor Searle said he knows the County is trying to keep these machines at 1,000 hours per year and he is concerned that a lot of roads in his district are not getting graded.

It was confirmed for Vice-Chairman English that when you include the trade-in value, the new machine could be purchased for approximately 60,000.

Mr. Ortega said that last fall, Highways & Floodplain suggested that we increase the number of service hours. Recently, Highways & Floodplain received authorization to hire temporary staff to get some of this work done and there will be additional staff to perform this work, shortly. He said customer service can be accomplished with 15 graders, instead of 17. There is an opportunity he recently learned of to keep one of these graders at the landfill and sell one of the older ones. He said the Board could delay this discussion with the potential ramification of possible impact for trade-in value.

Mr. Davis, Director, Heavy Fleet Director said the County has an opportunity to buy a new 2010 model grader; have only a few left and this is an opportunity to save \$8,000 now. In downsizing the grader fleet, we are now at 15 with approximately 1,000 hours per year on each. We have had a discussion about keeping machines longer, but it is about \$7-\$8 per hour cheaper to keep newer machines in Heavy Fleet.

Supervisor Searle Very tight with my own personal budget, think we should do the same with the County's budget. If you two think this is the way to go, I am fine with it.

Chairman Call said staff's recommendation is that this is the best approach; everyone knows the budget crunch that we are in and it is his tendency is to go with staff recommendation and expertise.

Vice-Chairman English said when we had the Work Session she thought that was the agreement of the Board to reduce the fleet and use machines longer. She sees this purchase as an economical way to get one new grader and a good trade-in value for the two old ones. She thinks that bringing the discussion to the forefront sends a message to the department about future purchases.

Mr. Ortega said that the message is loud and clear in terms of trying to find ways to maximize value to the taxpayer. He suggests selling the 1988 grader at the landfill and put one of the other ones out there. He concluded that we will bring replacement plans back to the Board annually.

Vice-Chairman English made a motion to approve the purchase of one (1) 2010 Caterpillar Model 140M Motor Grader from Empire Machinery Company in the amount of \$289,716.89 including sales tax in accordance with the terms, conditions and pricing of Invitation for Bids (IFB) No. 10-45-HFM-04. Supervisor Searle seconded the motion; approved 2-1 (Searle opposed).

Information Technologies

Item 8

APPROVE DECISION PACKAGE TO UPGRADE TO MICROSOFT EXCHANGE 2010 FOR COUNTYWIDE E-MAIL, INCLUDING THE NECESSARY HARDWARE, SOFTWARE AND CONSULTING AND INTEGRATION SERVICES, AT A TOTAL COST OF \$135,067 TO BE PAID FROM FUNDS ALLOCATED TO THE COUNTY IT INFRASTRUCTURE.

Vice-Chairman English made a motion to approve items 1 through 6 and 8 of the Consent Agenda. Supervisor Searle seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Community Development

Item 9

ADOPT RESOLUTION 11-17, AUTHORIZING THE EXCHANGE OF AN UNNECESSARY RIGHT-OF-WAY ADJACENT TO PRINCE ROAD FOR A NECESSARY RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR FRONTIER ROAD AS DESCRIBED THEREIN.

Supervisor Searle made a motion to Adopt Resolution 11-17, authorizing the exchange of an unnecessary right-of-way adjacent to Prince Road for a necessary right-of-way for Frontier Road as described therein. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion.

Ms. Patricia Morris, Deputy Community Development Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Morris stated the location and gave the background information on the property. In 1972 the state of Arizona secured 225' of right-of-way along Prince Road, apparently thinking that this would be a major highway. The right-of-way encroaches on Frontier Road. Mr. Owens, the property owner, has a building on the County's right-of-way. Since there are no plans to widen the road, the most reasonable exchange seemed to be for the County to get 1.2 acres on Frontier and provide Mr. Owens with 1.35 acre. This agreement was reached last year and will cost the County approximately \$60 to do the exchange which can be paid from the miscellaneous line item.

Vice-Chairman English had a conversation with Mr. Owen a couple of years ago and he agreed that this would be a good agreement. There is quite a curve and a drainage problem on the road. She said this is an equitable settlement for the County and Mr. Owens.

Mr. Edward Owens said surveys from the 1970s showed Prince Road at the fence line. This is a new survey. The center of Prince Road was the section line, under old surveys.

Chairman Call opened the public hearing.

No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the public hearing.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it carried unanimously.

Item 10

ADOPT RESOLUTION 11-18, ESTABLISHING CAMINO DE TUNDRA AS A DECLARED COUNTY HIGHWAY AS DESCRIBED THEREIN.

Vice-Chairman English made a motion to Adopt Resolution 11-18, establishing Camino De Tundra as a declared County Highway as described therein. Supervisor Searle seconded the motion.

Ms. Patricia Morris, Deputy Community Development Director, presented this item. Ms. Morris stated that the next two items are similar, part of spring Chip-seal program. Camino De Tundra is a mile-long section that is not chip-sealed that has an average daily traffic (ADT) count of 300 vehicles. We have adequate right-of-way and this project is part of the annual work plan budget. The department would like to begin this project as soon as possible.

Supervisor Searle said this project is funded by his discretionary funds. His philosophy has been to identify road projects in each one of his communities. He has already done projects in Sunsites, Pomerene, J-6 and is now trying to help the Whetstone area.

Chairman Call said that paving this road will help the entire County.

Chairman Call opened the public hearing.

No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the public hearing.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it carried unanimously.

Item 11

ADOPT RESOLUTION 11-19, ESTABLISHING A PORTION OF GLEESON ROAD AS A DECLARED COUNTY HIGHWAY AS DESCRIBED THEREIN.

Supervisor Searle made a motion to Adopt Resolution 11-19, establishing a portion of Gleeson Road as a declared County Highway as described therein. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion.

Ms. Patricia Morris Deputy Community Development Director, presented this item. Ms. Morris said last year the County chip sealed one mile of Gleeson Road with Vice-Chairman English's discretionary fund, this project will chip-seal another mile. The road is a major collector; although the ADT is not high, it is an important road to our system. This is a declaration process because we need to change the status from primitive road to County highway.

Vice-Chairman English confirmed that this mile was from Elfrida and last year's mile was from Tombstone.

Ms. Morris clarified that this mile is also from Tombstone.

Vice-Chairman English thought that this was the mile from Elfrida.

Mr. Ortega suggested moving forward with this declaration and to hold off on construction.

Ms. Morris said that is possible.

Vice-Chairman English said she needs to clarify with her constituents; she may have misinformed people because she had a different understanding of the project.

Mr. Hanson stated that a declaration would also be required for the other end of the road.

Supervisor Searle said he approved moving forward today and declaring the road.

Chairman Call as about the ramifications of declaring as a County highway now and but not doing the improvements.

Mr. Hanson said declaring a road as primitive, affords some protection from liability because there are different maintenance requirements for County highways versus primitive roads.

Vice-Chairman English said she is not opposed to paving this end, but she would like to have a discussion with Highways & Floodplains to have information to provide to her constituents. This road needs to be done and next year, she would like to do the other end of the road.

Supervisor Searle stated that this mile is a whole lot cheaper to do than the other end.

Chairman Call opened the public hearing.

No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the public hearing.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it carried unanimously.

ACTION AGENDA

Item 12

ADOPT RESOLUTION 11-20 TO RENEW COCHISE COUNTY'S MEMBERSHIP IN THE COCHISE COMBINED TRUST (CCT) EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2014.

Vice-Chairman English made a motion to Adopt Resolution 11-20 to renew Cochise County's membership in the Cochise Combined Trust (CCT) effective July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2014. Supervisor Searle seconded the motion.

Mr. Ortega said that Cochise College and the County joined the trust in 2002 and they are extending their membership for three years, through June 30, 2014 and are looking at adding more members to the trust to reduce costs.

Vice-Chairman English said as long as this is a cost-effective means to provide health insurance to our employees, we should continue.

Supervisor Searle said this is a complex issue and he knows that Mr. Ortega spends a lot of time on it.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it carried unanimously.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC – Chairman Call opened the Call to the Public. Mr. Jack Cook addressed the Board on matters of personal concern. No one else wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the Call to the Public.

REPORT BY MR. MIKE ORTEGA, COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, ON RECENT AND PENDING COUNTY MATTERS

Mr. Michael Ortega reported that he had some very unfortunate news: Cochise Health Systems did not receive the contract for Long-Term care. What this means is that we will cease to provide service as of September 30, 2011 and about 50 full-time employees will be lost; and it will be a \$1.5 million additional hit to the general fund for a full fiscal year. He said the obvious issue is what we will do with the employees, and whether layoffs are inevitable. He will be meeting Thursday with the successful bidder, Bridgeway to discuss personnel, equipment, etc. regarding transition. If there is any good news, it is that there were no other counties who received the bid so the state is obviously sending a strong message about privatizing this service.

SUMMARY OF CURRENT EVENTS BY BOARD MEMBERS

REPORT BY SUPERVISOR PAT CALL, DISTRICT NO. 1

Chairman Call said there was a 2-day Stormwater Capture seminar last week; experts were brought in from throughout the Southwest to discuss. He said we are moving forward with U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service regarding coordination services. On May 11th he will be attending the Upper San Pedro Partnership (USPP) PAC meeting; on May 16th he will be meeting with Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) for water resources committee to bring possible legislative changes to the state; and there is a public meeting with the National Riparian Systems Team on May 18th.

REPORT BY SUPERVISOR ANN ENGLISH, DISTRICT NO. 2

Vice-Chairman English deferred her report but wanted to make a statement about the state Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) program. She said in reading the letter they sent, it just says 'you have not been chosen'. It is a well-known fact that Cochise County has a remarkable program and are proficient at providing that service. It upsets her to know we were doing something right and now the state has chosen to privatize this program.

REPORT BY SUPERVISOR RICHARD SEARLE, DISTRICT NO. 3

Supervisor Searle said the Coronado Resource Conservation and Development (RC&D) has lost federal budgeted funding. The support is gone, but RC&D is going to stay in operation, out of the University of Arizona Extension office in Willcox. There are still two years of grants to administer and they are going to do their best to keep this effort alive.

Chairman Call adjourned the meeting at 10:59 a.m.
