

**RESOLUTION 11-\_\_\_\_\_**

**DESIGNATING THE BOWIE, SAN SIMON, WINCHESTER  
HEIGHTS, LOWER HUACHUCA CITY, AND FRY  
TOWNSITE AREAS AS COLONIAS WITHIN  
COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA**

**WHEREAS**, the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 (Pub. L. 101-625, Nov. 28, 1990) (the Act) defines a colonia as any identifiable community (i.e., with defined boundaries) within 150 miles of the United States-Mexico border in Arizona, California, New Mexico and Texas, that was in existence before November 28, 1990, excluding metropolitan statistical areas with populations exceeding one million. The community must be determined to be a colonia on the basis of objective criteria including the lack of potable water supply, lack of adequate sewage systems, and lack of decent, safe and sanitary housing; and

**WHEREAS**, incorporated and unincorporated communities within Cochise County, Arizona, which lack potable water supplies, adequate sewage systems, and/or decent, safe and sanitary housing, adequate roads and drainage are eligible for designation as a Colonia; and

**WHEREAS**, designation as a Colonia is necessary before certain state and federal funds can be made available to improve infrastructure systems and housing within those communities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bowie, San Simon, Winchester Heights, Lower Huachuca City, and Fry Townsite areas existed as Colonias before November 28, 1990; and

**WHEREAS**, boundary maps of Bowie San Simon, Winchester Heights, Lower Huachuca City, and Fry Townsite are attached as Exhibit "A," incorporated herein,


