

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON  
TUESDAY, JULY 26, 2011**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, July 26, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Patrick Call, Chair; Ann English, Vice-Chairman; Richard Searle, Supervisor; Michael Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Britt W. Hanson, Chief Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Call called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

**Board of Supervisors**

1. Approve the appointment of Amanda Baillie to the Local Workforce Investment Board to fill an open seat, effective immediately and through 6/30/2012.

Approve Intergovernmental Agreement #ADHS 11-005806 Amendment 2, Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Services, Breastfeeding Peer Counselor Program (BFPC), and the Farmer's Market Nutrition Program (FMNP), between the Arizona Department of Health Services and the Cochise County Health Department in the amount of \$647,049, \$64,596 and \$787.50 respectively, for the period of 10/1/11 – 9/30/12.

Approve a Grant Agreement between the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission and the Cochise County Sheriff's Office for a United States Department of Justice grant, No. DC-12-030 and DC-12-030 Exhibit A, for a term of July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012, providing \$175,210 in salary, fringe benefit, and overtime funding for the Sheriff's Office personnel assigned to the Border Alliance Group (BAG).

Vice-Chairman English made a motion to approve items 1 through 16 of the Consent Agenda. Supervisor Searle seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

## **PUBLIC HEARINGS**

### **Community Development**

17. Adopt Resolution 11-34 to approve Docket CP-11-01, Cochise County Policies Regarding Federal Government Lands.

Mr. Michael Turisk, Interim Planning Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Turisk explained the policies for discussion and the importance of having the county participate in the discussion of federal lands in the area. He gave the definition of coordination between federal and local government. He stated the land use decisions impact the county greatly so it is crucial that the county be involved in any decision making regarding land use. He then discussed the criteria for coordination between the 2 governments.

Mr. Turisk outlined the background of how the policies were formed with several slides noting that the Public Lands Advisory Committee, appointed by the Board of Supervisors, had a lot of important input in the types of policies approved by the Board. Mr. Turisk briefly discussed the specific policies. He said staff recommended that the Board approve CP-11-01 in order to formally sanction inclusion of the policies in the County's Comprehensive Plan document, as recommended by the PLAC and the Planning and Zoning Commission.

Chairman Call opened the public hearing.

Mr. Mike Quigley, Wilderness Society, stated that although he agreed with the intent is of the county to participate in discussions with the state and federal government, he had some concerns about some sections: specifically section 2a and b and 2a3 and 2b1, which in his opinion were factually unsupportable. A blanket rejection of citizens' concerns he thought was unnecessary and unproductive. He said that those sections sent a message dialogue with county citizens was unnecessary. He requested that the sections discussed above be removed from the document.

Mr. Rod Mondt, Sky Island Alliance, wanted the Board to amend the language for the comprehensive plan. He stated that his group was in support, but were concerned about parts of the document, especially protected areas of the wilderness. He wanted the Board to strike sections 2a and 2b from the document.

Ms. Greta Anderson, Director of Western Watersheds Project commended the county for getting involved. She had specific concerns regarding San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area (SPRNCA) and why grazing should not be allowed in the area as well as the section on endangered species. She requested that the Board table the item and revise the document before approving.

Ms. Tricia Gerrodette, concerned citizen, stated that she though the county should have a better understanding of certain topics before approving the document.

Mr. Ronald Serviss, concerned citizen and also the president of Friends of the San Pedro River, stated he was worried about the rapid changes that are occurring in this area. He said that although his group was very involved in anything concerning the river and had worked with the Bureau of Land Management, he had not been aware of this policy discussion and wanted the Board to table the item.

Mr. Robert Dowdy, Arizona Wilderness Coalition, showed concern about the policies. He said there was a necessity for open space and areas for people to interact with nature. He understood the need for the county to be involved in coordinating issues with state and federal agencies, but felt citizens should have input too.

Mr. Robert Luce, concerned citizen, stated that he thought the project needed a lot of development. He suggested to the Board to table the item until it could be reworked and reworded.

Chairman Call closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman English commented on the length of the process for the policies and stated that the in her opinion the item was too detailed. Supervisor Searle agreed with Vice-Chairman English in that the wording on the document is not very flexible. She recommended the following changes be made:

Under A. Wilderness Designation 3. add always after not.

Under B. Other Designations 1. Delete are and add may be after non-use. 2. Delete the whole section. 3. Add "or management plan" after special designations and delete other methods to add "well-planned and managed development".

Under C. Introduced, Threatened, Endangered and Sensitive Species, Recovery Plans, Experimental Populations and Related Guidelines and Protocols 1. Delete often and put could and delete can and add may.  
Under G. Wildlife 3. Delete "increase in" and add "availability of" and add "documented" before "increase".

Supervisor Richard Searle made a motion to adopt Resolution 11-34 to approve Docket CP-11-01, Cochise County Policies Regarding Federal Government Lands with changes suggested by Supervisor English.

Supervisor Searle withdraws motion to accept new changes.

Chairman Call added the following changes: Under the San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area (SPRNCA) 5. Delete "minimized in order to help return the aquifer to historic levels" and add "managed to help".

Supervisor Searle moves to note changes. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion.

Chairman Call clarified that document can be changed or added too if need be in the future.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it was approved unanimously.

### **Solid Waste Management**

18. Adopt Resolution 11-35 to approve an increase Solid Waste tipping fee from \$50 to \$51 per ton, effective September 1, 2011.

Chairman Call says that the item will be tabled to the August 9, 2011 Regular Board of Supervisors Meeting in order for the department to revise wording on the agenda.

## ***ACTION***

### **Cochise Aging & Social Services**

19. Approve the agreement between Cochise County and Southeast Arizona Behavioral Health Services (SEABHS) for Title 36 Mental Health Services.

Ms. Mary Gomez, Health Director, presented this item. Ms. Gomez explained the title 36 services from SEABHS and that this item had to do with payment timelines. Currently the daily price was \$600 a day and the staff was recommending increasing that amount to \$750 a day. She noted that this was the same amount the county pays all our facilities in Tucson. She stated that the benefit of having this locally, besides economic benefit, was that everyone involved would be local. Supervisor Searle asked if she thought that SEABHS would be able to provide service in the future and Ms. Gomez stated that although they are struggling she thought that they were still going to be in business in the future.

Supervisor Searle made a motion to approve the agreement between Cochise County and Southeast Arizona Behavioral Health Services (SEABHS) for Title 36 Mental Health Services. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

## ***CALL TO THE PUBLIC***

Chairman Call opened the Call to the Public. Mr. Jack Cook addressed the Board on matters of personal concern. No one else wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the Call to the Public.

## ***REPORT BY MICHAEL J. ORTEGA, COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR -- RECENT AND PENDING COUNTY MATTERS***

Mr. Ortega stated that Graham and Greenlee Counties for workforce development act would be taken over by the state and that there was an opportunity for Cochise County to help its neighbors. Also, there would be election director interviews that afternoon. Next Monday we have the final adoption of budget and on Tuesday a supervisory training session with a motivational speaker. He also stated that he would be attending the Arizona City/County Management Association (ACMA) Conference later in the week.
