

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2011**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, September 27, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Patrick Call, Chair; Ann English, Vice-Chairman; Richard Searle, Supervisor; Michael Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Britt W. Hanson, Chief Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Katie Howard, Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Call called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m.

CONSENT

Adopt Resolution 11-45 cancelling the Bowie Fire District Special Governing Board Election of November 8, 2011 for three (3) board seats up for election and appointing the one (1) candidate (Debra Juarez) who filed to run in the election to fill one (1) of the three (3) open board positions with all the powers and duties of that office as if elected to that office, effective the 1st day of December, 2011 and declaring the other two (2) open board positions vacant effective the 1st day of December, 2011.

Supervisor Searle made a motion to approve items 1 through 9 of the Consent Agenda. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Community Development

10. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 11-08, to approve Docket Z-08-11R (APS), rezoning Parcel 407-61-023L from Heavy Industrial (HI) back to RU-4, pursuant to the request by APS to revert the previously approved rezoning for this parcel.

Vice-Chairman English made a motion to adopt Zoning Ordinance 11-08, to approve Docket Z-08-11R (APS), rezoning Parcel 407-61-023L from Heavy Industrial (HI) back to RU-4, pursuant to the request by APS to revert the previously approved rezoning for this parcel. Supervisor Searle seconded the motion.

Mr. Keith Dennis, Senior Planner, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Dennis mentioned that the applicant was not present. He said this request is to rezone the parcel that was originally rezoned to HI in 2008 back to RU; due to the economy the applicant is unsure about future plans and requests revocation to RU4. The applicant could pursue as a special use permit in the RU district in the future if they wished to do so. Mr. Dennis showed the location map along Paul Spur Road, off Highway 80 between Bisbee and Douglas.

Vice-Chairman English commented that this request seemed pretty straightforward.

Mr. Dennis explained why this item was not put on Consent Agenda (not allowed by zoning regulations).

Chairman Call opened the public hearing. No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the public hearing.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

11. (TABLED ITEM (*From 8/23/11 Board Meeting*)): Adopt Zoning Ordinance 11-09 to (1) amend certain Cochise County zoning districts boundaries from, RU-4 (Rural, one dwelling per 4 acres), to PD (Planned Development District), (2) amend the Cochise County Comprehensive Plan, and (3) approve a master development plan, pursuant to the application of James Lee of Madison Diversified.

Supervisor Searle made a motion to remove this item from the table. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion. Approved 3-0.

Vice-Chairman English made a motion to adopt Zoning Ordinance 11-09 to (1) amend certain Cochise County zoning districts boundaries from, RU-4 (Rural, one dwelling per 4 acres), to PD (Planned Development District), (2) amend the Cochise County Comprehensive Plan, and (3) approve a master development plan, pursuant to the application of James Lee of Madison Diversified. Supervisor Searle seconded the motion.

Mr. Keith Dennis, Senior Planner, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Dennis said that this item had been discussed at a Work Session after the initial public hearing. This is a 4-phase 1,240 acre Master Development Plan with a variety of different housing types. He showed the location approximately three miles west of Willcox. Discussion at the Work Session included approval conditions, staff diligence and possible further Board

action with the understanding that infrastructure would be provided by developer. Additionally, the Board asked for a contribution of \$109,016 to ongoing Airport Road improvements as opposed to what was in the traffic study and added Condition #1 requiring the exaction prior to any development of Phase 1. Other changes require a dedication of Right-of-Way within 90 days of Board approval; and addition of Condition #10 that covers water conservation measures. Staff is recommending conditional approval as outlined.

Supervisor Searle asked at what point does the \$109,016 get paid.

Mr. David Bonham with Kinetics Engineering said they have been discussing modifications and would like to propose to the Board that the amount be cut in half: half paid now, half paid later during the Phase 1 development; the developer has okayed the 50% upfront payment.

Supervisor Searle stated that he did not have a problem working out such an arrangement with second half payable with subdivision approval and/or sale of lots.

Vice-Chairman English said this subdivision will be 3 miles from Willcox and in the direction that they are growing. She asked if we have made any effort to see if Willcox is interested in annexing this area.

Mr. Dennis showed the western boundary of the City of Willcox and stated that it will be quite a leap to extend out that far.

Supervisor Searle indicated that there is interest on the part of the City of Willcox to annex, but not much interest by the residents there.

Vice-Chairman English stated that we need to be nudging Willcox because we cannot continue to extend our services.

Chairman Call asked regarding official trigger for payment of second half payment.

There was a discussion among the Board, Mr. Carlos de la Torre and Mr. Dave Fifer about when the second half of the payment would be paid and the wording of the amended motion.

Supervisor Searle amended the motion to require 50% of the road exaction fee before any building permits are issued and the other 50% after 20 units have been completed. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion.

Chairman Call opened the public hearing. No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the public hearing.

Mr. Dennis read sample language for agreement to ensure the Board agreed with that: During the development of Phase 1, the developer should provide the County with exaction toward improvement cost for the currently scheduled Airport Road paving project in the amount of \$109,016. This exaction will be paid as followed; 50% due prior to the issuance of the first building permit; the remaining 50% will be due prior to the issuance of the permit of the 21st unit; the remaining recommendations of the August 23, 2011 traffic study done by Task Engineering will be binding on the project; future traffic study recommendations will also be adhered to as the project develops.

The Board gave comments regarding large communities near incorporated cities and the necessity to have conversations about annexations in a Work Session setting.

Chairman Call called for the vote on the original motion as amended and it carried 3-0.

12. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 11-10 to approve Docket R-11-03, amending Article 20 and Section 2003 of the Cochise County Zoning Regulations to continue, change or modify non-conforming land uses, lots and structures in order to provide regulatory relief to property owners affected by catastrophic events declared emergencies by the Board, such as the recent Monument and Horseshoe II fires.

Supervisor Searle made a motion to approve Docket R-11-03, amending Article 20 and Section 2003 of the Cochise County Zoning Regulations to continue, change or modify non-conforming land uses, lots and structures in order to provide regulatory relief to property owners affected by catastrophic events declared emergencies by the Board, such as the recent Monument and Horseshoe II fires. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion.

Mr. Michael Turisk, Interim Planning Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Turisk restated the purpose of the item and reviewed Article 20 (non-conforming lots or parcels) of the existing Zoning Regulations and explained that they require residents to come in compliance if use of property is discontinued, in accordance with site development standards in current regulations. The proposed revision would allow property owners whose properties are destroyed in catastrophic events if the Board declares an emergency, to rebuild structures as non-forming (i.e., they would be exempt from the compliance requirement of Article 20 and also streamlines the process to rebuild).

Mr. Turisk clarified that this revision only applies to situations where the Board has declared an emergency in an area affecting the property. He added that staff has done a quick review of non-conforming lots that are out there and does not believe this will become a big problem.

Chairman Call opened the public hearing. No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the public hearing.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

13. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 11-11 to approve Docket R-11-04, amending the existing Cochise County Building Safety Code Owner-Builder Amendment Option, and to Section 508 of the Cochise County Zoning Regulations allowing property owners whose structures were damaged or destroyed by catastrophic events that the Board of Supervisors declares an emergency, and who wish to repair or rebuild on properties less than four acres to qualify for this option.

Supervisor Searle made a motion to adopt Zoning Ordinance 11-11 to approve Docket R-11-04, amending the existing Cochise County Building Safety Code Owner-Builder Amendment Option, and to Section 508 of the Cochise County Zoning Regulations allowing property owners whose structures were damaged or destroyed by catastrophic events that the Board of Supervisors declares an emergency, and who wish to repair or rebuild on properties less than four acres to qualify for this option. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion.

Mr. Michael Turisk, Interim Planning Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Turisk stated that this was also an effort to streamline the process for property owners. This particular amendment would allow an affected property owner to opt out of building inspections, as currently allowed with RU-4 opt out provisions.

Chairman Call opened the public hearing.

No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the public hearing.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

14. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 11-12 to approve Docket R-11-05, codifying the Board of Supervisors' authority to determine when existing uses or structures would be rendered non-conforming as a result of a rezoning action due to different site development standards.

Vice-Chairman English made a motion to approve Docket R-11-05, codifying the Board of Supervisors' authority to determine when existing uses or structures would be rendered non-conforming as a result of a rezoning action due to different site development standards. Supervisor Searle seconded the motion.

Mr. Michael Turisk, Interim Planning Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Turisk stated that staff has brought to the Board rezoning requests which did not meet setback requirements and were thus non-conforming. This is an effort to codify the Board's authority to waive or modify site development standards for the new zoning district. He reviewed an example and read the proposed amendment to Article 22. On September 14 the Planning and Zoning Commission unanimously recommended approval.

Chairman Call opened the public hearing.

Mr. Jack Cook commented on this item.

No one else wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman English said she thinks this is a great move.

Supervisor Searle and Chairman Call complimented staff on bringing the item forward.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

ACTION

Board of Supervisors

15. Adopt Resolution 11-___ supporting the Brophy Land Exchange or Resolution 11-___ not supporting the Brophy Land Exchange.

Mr. Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator presented this item. Mr. Vlahovich said this request is from Mr. Brophy, President of Page Land and Cattle Company to support a land exchange involving private property in Cochise County to transfer to the Forest Service in exchange for public land in the White Mountains. He described the area of the three parcels consisting of 560 acres. In 1995 the Forest Service advised the Lions Foundation of Arizona that their lease of the camp was in jeopardy of non-renewal if they could not acquire the camp in a land exchange. Mr. Brophy has been involved with the exchange since 1996. He has recently been advised by the Forest Service that under new NEPA policies, land exchanges should not occur without compensation to the County. If these new policies are strictly enforced, it would basically negate over fifteen years of work from his firm and the Lions Foundation, therefore, he is requesting an exception to these three properties.

Supervisor Searle had requested the Public Lands Advisory Committee (PLAC) to review. On September 6, PLAC met and their decision was based on the fact that this is the first application of the policy since enacted.

Mr. Vlahovich said the total property taxes assessed for these three parcels for 2011 are \$56.52. The County requested that the County Attorney's Office prepare two resolutions—one in support and one opposed. The opinion from the Attorney's office states: The County's new policy does not bind the Forest Service and thus does not prohibit the proposed land exchange and also pointed out that the third policy states that the private land owner has the right to dispose or exchange of property as he/she sees fit; no net affect on this exchange. Mr. Brophy conveyed to Mr. Vlahovich that the Forest Service takes these land exchanges seriously and are interested in the opinion of local jurisdictions and if the Board does not oppose, the Forest Service would look favorably on that opinion.

Mr. Brophy, President of Page Land and Cattle Company, said he appreciates the Board taking this item up and also the PLAC's consideration. Cochise County has been more adversely affected by Forest Service policy than any other county in the state, except for Apache County. Mr. Brophy outlined the history of the property and described the arrangement for the exchange that started about ten years ago that occurred on a crest of Forest Service requirement changes for land exchanges. Because of dispute over home owner's fees, two neighbors opposed the land exchange causing the Lions Foundation to undertake an expensive environmental impact statement. He said land exchanges are ministerial acts; the Forest Service takes these kinds of policies affecting land exchanges very seriously and need the land exchange approved to make the values of the land exchange equal. His company has done business in Cochise County and other parts of Arizona with the Forest Service since the 50's and it has made a difference in how the state has developed—he gave examples and history.

Supervisor Searle asked in this particular land exchange—how many acres are on both sides?

Mr. Brophy said the land exchange requires value per value, not acre for acre. On an acre per acre basis, it is always in favor of the Forest Service. He did not have the exact figures but he recalled this exchange as 1,800 acres of private land for 344 acres of forest land; approximately one-third is in Cochise County.

Supervisor Searle said he was amazed that the Forest Service paid attention to our NEPA policy and he is in a quandary; wants to support PLAC but also thinks Mr. Brophy made some good points and the impact on Cochise County is minimal.

Vice-Chairman English commented that the Board put PLAC in place and they are to make recommendations to the Board. She said she thinks we should ask our groups to tell us why they are voting the way they are. For this particular land exchange, approval would be the better option because it would benefit a group that helps handicapped children.

Chairman Call supports the recommendation of the PLAC but that does not mean the Board does not have the opportunity to consider things one at a time, without setting a precedent for the future and this land exchange effort pre-dates the new policy.

Supervisor Searle made a motion to adopt Resolution 11-46 supporting the Brophy Land Exchange. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

REPORT BY MICHAEL J. ORTEGA, COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR -- RECENT AND PENDING COUNTY MATTERS

Mr. Ortega reported that the Work Session for the Human Resources policy review is this afternoon and he will then solicit feedback from Department Directors and employees. He is working with staff to formalize the wellness program and will bring recommendations to the Board soon. He said this week is the last full week for the Cochise Health Systems employees; losing 47 people—their last day is this Friday. He will be attending the County Supervisors Association (CSA) summit next week along with Supervisor Searle; and reminded Chairman Call and Vice-Chairman English that they can give their proxy votes to Supervisor Searle.

Chairman Call opened the Call to the Public.

Mr. Jack Cook addressed the Board on matters of personal concern.

No one else wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the Call to the Public.
