PROCLAMATION

2012 Presidential Preference Election

WHEREAS, 2012 is a presidential election year in the United States of America;

WHEREAS, Arizona is at the forefront of reviving federalism and advancing solutions to national issues such as illegal immigration and border security, Medicaid spending and the fiscal crisis facing governments throughout the country; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statute § 16-241(A) and (B), Arizona's presidential preference election is to be held on the fourth Tuesday in February of a presidential election year, unless the Governor decides to hold the presidential preference election on an earlier date.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Janice K. Brewer, Governor of the State of Arizona, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Arizona Constitution and laws of the State of Arizona, do hereby proclaim and order that Arizona's 2012 Presidential Preference election shall remain on the fourth Tuesday in February and be held on February 28, 2012.
