

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 15, 2011**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, November 15 2011 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Patrick Call, Chair; Ann English, Vice-Chairman; Richard Searle, Supervisor; Michael Ortega, County Administrator; Britt Hanson, Chief Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Kim Lemons, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Call called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Vice-Chairman English made a motion to approve items 1 through 11 of the Consent Agenda. Supervisor Searle seconded the motion and it carried unanimously

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Board of Supervisors

12. Determine the validity of the petitions received from the organizers of the proposed Sunsites Community Park Maintenance District.

Pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.03(A)(3) and (4), the Board of Supervisors may vote to go into Executive Session for discussion or consultation for legal advice with the attorney or attorneys of the public body and for discussion or consultation with the attorneys of the public body in order to consider its position and instruct its attorneys regarding the public body's position regarding contracts that are the subject of negotiations, in pending or contemplated litigation or in settlement discussions conducted in order to avoid or resolve litigation.

Ms. Juanita Simmons, Elections Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Simmons gave the background of the proposed formation of the park maintenance district — when the impact and amended impact statement were submitted; the March 15, 2011 Board's approval of the amended impact statement and authorization to begin collecting the signatures with the following four stipulations: 1) organizers had one year to submit signatures; 2) signatures of one-half the property owners; 3) signatures of persons owning collectively one-half of the assessed valuation of the property within the proposed district; and 4) signatures of more than one-half of registered voters. On April 1, 2011 the Clerk of the Board certified the signature requirements: 265 Registered Voters, 556 Property Owners and \$4,281,302.51 Assessed Values. On October 31, 2011 the petitions were submitted with the first three stipulations being met but not the fourth. Ms. Simmons showed a map of the proposed park maintenance district and the results from the Assessor's Office of the petitions submitted on October 31st. She concluded with issues the Board may want to consider: non-submission of registered voters required by the Board; "clouds" on the lease; and the extra parcel in the lease that brings the total acreage in the district above 160 acres. She also stated the next steps if the Board approves the formation of the district: resolution signed and recorded within 30 days; lease conveyed to the district; and organizing board will need to begin implementation. No other action is required if the Board does not approve the formation.

The Board and Mr. Hanson agreed that the discussion should be public and not handled through an executive session.

Mr. Hanson used a PowerPoint to present the legal issues of the formation of this park maintenance district. He said the signatures of registered voters requirement was eliminated in 2010 from one statute but not another and in March he advised the Board that even though it was not required they may want to require them in case this was ever challenged in the future. His research subsequent to that time period indicated that a Board does not have the right to require that stipulation versus requesting it. Also, the statute does not clarify if property owners are the number of parcels or people and the Assessor's Office and the Clerk of the Board used the number of parcels equation. He said if he could go back in time he would have advised the Assessor and the Clerk of the Board to use the number of people versus parcels. Although that is the preferred way he said the Board should use the number of signatures that

were determined by the Clerk of the Board and verified by the Assessor's Office in determining the validity of the petitions received.

Chairman Call asked if other counties in Arizona were solicited about their methodology for counting voters.

Mr. Hanson said yes and the methodology Cochise County uses puts it in the minority.

Mr. Hanson cited several broad statutes that covered the Board's discretion in ordering the formation of a district. Mr. Hanson reviewed another legal issue which is the size of a park district. The legislature defines a park district as 160 acres or less. If formed, the district will acquire a lease that would put the park district over 160 acres because it includes an extra acre; this discrepancy will need to be addressed, not today but once the district is formed.

Supervisor Searle asked about the County's responsibility to enforce the 160 acre regulations.

Vice-Chairman English stated the organizers have known about the extra acreage issue and have not addressed it. She also said that the Clerk of the Board and everyone else were present in March and she left that meeting having heard that the property owners would be counted only once and the other Board members were in agreement and that was their intent and it did not happen.

Mr. Hanson said this is not a good position for the County to be in but ultimately it is in the Board's hands to determine the validity of the petitions.

Chairman Call opened the public hearing.

Mr. John A. MacKinnon, spoke on behalf of the proponents of the park district. He said the organizers, staff and everyone have struggled with this and the legislators have not been very helpful with the process. He agreed with Mr. Hanson regarding the registered voters' requirement and said there is no requisite for electors to sign. On the issue of the number of property owners, the statutes are not clear. In his opinion for the formation of special districts each parcel has an owner and each owner should be counted because each property will be assessed and that is how the taxes will be levied. On the lease issue he said the district does not own the lease; on the discretion issue, he said the Board has properly executed it and he respectfully requests the Board support this district.

Supervisor Searle asked if there is any case law on this in Arizona.

Mr. MacKinnon replied no.

Ms. Adriane Parsons spoke on behalf of a group of property owners in opposition to the park district called Sunsites Concerned Citizens. She said there are two big issues: the first is the validity of the petitions and the second is the district has to be formed first before the lease can be addressed. She said the owners of the property have not responded, only the tenants of the lease, and they have not seen the lease. She said this is a privately owned golf course and the purpose of the formation is to tax people to maintain this property. She stated that all the stipulations of the Board should stand including the registered voters requirement in order for submission of the petitions to be on a level playing field. In closing she said ultimately, the proponents of the park district carry the burden to persuade the Board that they have complied with all the statutes.

Mr. Hanson addressed Ms. Parsons' questions regarding the lease; gave the legislators definition of a community park as being an area dedicated for unrestricted public use; and the Board's use of discretion.

Vice-Chairman English asked if the Impact Statement was definitive enough regarding the financial burden the public would assume, was that sufficient for today's purposes.

Mr. Hanson said the Impact Statement is not required to be perfect, only sufficient and cannot be redone now. He also said the district would not take on the liens but would be subject to them.

Mr. MacKinnon wanted to clarify a point regarding the Impact Statement and all the different obligations that may be associated with this property. He said this district can only spend money to maintain this property it cannot spend money to acquire this property or to pay off those leases.

Mr. Jackson, spoke in opposition to the formation of the park maintenance district.

No one else wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman English said she does not agree with the methodology used to count the petitions.

Supervisor Searle said there are two issues under considerations today, the validity of petitions and the formation of the district.

Supervisor Searle made a motion to approve the validity of the petitions received from the organizers of the proposed Sunsites Community Park Maintenance District. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion.

Chairman Call asked for Mr. Hanson's recommendations.

Mr. Hanson recapped, his opinion is there are only two requirements to be met; that they do not need the registered voters' requirement. Those two requirements have been met as determined by the Clerk of the Board, which we are bound by.

Vice-Chairman English said the decision to make is do we believe that we made a decision to put a requirement on this district they chose to ignore and whether we can impose it; Mr. Hanson said we cannot. At the time, acting on good faith and on the information we were given, we thought it was the one criteria we could impose to help the public come to a consensus. Today, it is a lose/lose position.

Chairman Call said the information the Board received was not good and we did not have the authorized to require the registered voters and this is not an easy decision but the criteria has been met.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it carried 2-0-1, English opposed.

13. Adopt Resolution 11-51 ordering that the Sunsites Community Park Maintenance District be established.

Chairman Call opened the public hearing. No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Call closed the public hearing.

Supervisor Searle said he was very frustrated and embarrassed about how this whole process has gone on in more than one way. He understands this is new ground for Cochise County, but the results are far from acceptable and do not build confidence in Cochise County leadership. He said the information and advice Mr. Hanson have given has been inconsistent, contradicting and confusing. Mr. Ortega, the Board staff has also made its fair share of errors. The Special District and Board staff were at the March meeting and heard the discussions and either did not correct us or did not follow through with the Board's wishes. Supervisor Searle apologized to the Sunsites community. He said there should have been more oversight and ultimately as representative for the community he is partially responsible. He continued that he is also embarrassed and frustrated by how the community of Sunsites has handled this. Pearce-Sunsites is his home. He understands and respects those who do not want this green space or do not want to pay more taxes but not the allegations of greed, ignorance and/or corruption that have been spread for the last six to seven months. He was at the community meeting in Pearce 3 years ago, over 400 people showed their support to keep the golf course going when the out of town developers/owners left. He believes the golf course, built by Horizon Corporation is what sets the community apart; and the residents have benefited from this unique space with no direct cost to them. The parks maintenance district is probably the most equitable way to maintain this space long term. The ownership issue is a concern. Over time the donations of funds do not come in and the volunteer labor force slows down and stops. Because of the restrictions put on a park district they cannot bail out the current property owners. The reason for the formation is for the sole benefit for the community not the owners of the golf course. As a Board we have a no win situation; both sides have grounds to sue and we are looking at a lawsuit either way. He believes the golf course will not be maintained if the district is not formed. Supervisor Searle said he supports the formation of the district but asked the organizers to listen to the community. He does not think they need an 18-hole golf course; 9-holes on the south side of Ironwood would preserve the green space. He added, if the organizing board is lucky enough to get this approved today, he suggested they keep the public funds separate so they can prove this money is going for maintenance only.

Chairman English said the biggest regret for her is there have been a significant number of people in Sunsites who have opposed this idea from the beginning and insinuated that there are other ways to do this but those ideas have not been brought before the Board for consideration. This is a new venture for Cochise County and she apologized for the lack of oversight or understanding that resulted in the Board's wishes not being carried out. She has questioned many issues that have come up regarding this formation and because of the type of information received whatever decision the Board makes today will probably result in a lawsuit.

Chairman Call echoed Supervisor Searle and Vice-Chairman English's comments, this process has been poorly handled and too many errors have been made, but it stops with the Board. He agreed with Supervisor Searle that the community is better off with the golf course than without it.

Supervisor Searle made a motion to adopt Resolution 11-51 ordering that the Sunsites Community Park Maintenance District be established. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it carried 2-1, English opposed.
