**GENERAL PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

① **City of Bisbee Bus Transit System (Direct LTAF II Award, 5311, 5317, AAA)**

Operates 6 days per week  
Serves the areas of Bisbee and Naco

② **City of Sierra Vista Transit System (Direct LTAF II Award, LTAF, 5311)**

Operates 7 days per week

Serves 186,867 persons (annual basis)

**SPECIAL NEEDS TRANSPORTATION**

④ **Cochise County Association for the Handicapped (5310, 5316)**

Contracts with the Department of Economic Security Rehabilitation Services (RSA), and the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DDD) to provide vocational and residential services to people with disabilities  
Operates 7 days per week  
Serves Southeastern Arizona  
☑ Participates in SEAGO Transit Meetings  
Serves 38-52 persons (daily basis)

⑤ **Douglas Association for Retarded Citizens (City of Douglas, 5310)**

Provides transportation to the elderly and persons with disabilities  
Operates 5 days per week  
Serves the areas of Douglas, Bisbee, Double Adobe, Elfrida  
☑ Participates in SEAGO Transit Meetings  
Serves 2,950 persons (annual basis)

⑥ **Northern Cochise Community Hospital (5310)**

Provides transportation to the general public (limited), to the elderly and persons with disabilities  
Operates 40 hours per week  
Serves the areas of Willcox, Sunsites/Pearce, Richland, Cochise, Bowie, San Simon  
☑ Participates in SEAGO Transit Meetings  
Serves 80 persons (monthly basis)

⑦ **Town of Huachuca City**

Provides door to door transportation to the elderly and persons with disabilities

Services available 5 days per week

Serves the Town of Huachuca City

Willing to participate in SEAGO Transit Meetings

Serves 1,550 persons (annual basis)

⑧ **Volunteer Interfaith Caregiver Program (Sierra Vista)**

Provides free transportation (via privately owned vehicles by volunteers) to the elderly and persons with disabilities

Operates 5 days per week

Serves the areas of Benson, Bisbee, Huachuca City, Sierra Vista, Hereford, Palominas, Whetstone

# THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) Section 5300

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5300 Rural Public Transportation Programs provide funds for capital, administrative, and operating assistance to local public bodies and nonprofit organizations for the operation of public transportation services in non-urbanized areas.

## TRANSIT/TRANSPORTATION PROGRAMS

### **Section 5310 - Elderly Individuals and Individuals with Disabilities**

Provides capital funding for transportation projects that serve the elderly and individuals with disabilities. Funds are typically used to purchase vehicles and related equipment. Also supports Mobility Management activities.

### **Section 5311—Rural Public Transit**

Provides operating, administrative and capital funding for public, fixed route and para-transit programs in non-urbanized areas.

### **Section 5316 - Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC)**

Provides operating and capital funding for transportation projects that serve low income individuals who need transportation to work or to work-related activities. Funds can be used to purchase vehicles and related equipment and pay for operating expenses directly related to the program. Also supports Mobility Management activities.

### **Section 5317 - New Freedom**

Provides operating and capital funding that address the transportation needs of persons with disabilities above and beyond those required by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Also supports Mobility Management activities.
