Includes an emergency clause.	House Appropriations
<a href="#">HB 2360:</a>	flood control districts; immunity ( <i>Fann</i> )	A county flood control district and its employees are not liable for any injury or property damage arising out of a flood control project when a reasonably adequate warning of any unreasonably dangerous hazard is given to potentially affected property owners. <a href="#">HB 2361:</a>	consumer fireworks; regulation ( <i>Fann</i> )	Municipalities and counties are authorized to regulate the sale and use of permissible consumer fireworks.	House Mil Aff & PS
