

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON  
TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 28, 2012**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, February 28, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Richard Searle, Chairman; Patrick Call, Vice-Chairman; Ann English, Supervisor; Michael Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator, David Fifer, Deputy County Attorney; and Katie Howard, Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Searle called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Chairman Searle opened the Call to the Public. No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Searle closed the Call to the Public.

## **Fleet**

7. Approve a month to month extension of Contract No. 10-38-HFM-04 with Pro Petroleum Inc., not to exceed three months, for bulk (unleaded and diesel) fuel for the Light and Heavy Fleet Management departments.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve items 1-7 of the Consent Agenda. Supervisor English seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

## **ACTION**

### **Board of Supervisors**

8. Consider and take action to approve, amend or disapprove the Decision Packages listed on Exhibit A.

Mr. Michael Ortega, County Administrator presented this item. Mr. Ortega pointed out that the JP4 is a court enhancement project and has been completed; there are three Elections Decision Packages, all grant funded and all done.

Chairman Searle confirmed that total was \$67,000.

Mr. Ortega confirmed and stated that this included the Special Revenue Funds. He added that these are all the Decision Packages that were received for the 2011-12 fiscal year and reminded the Board that the Decision Packages had been deferred until mid-year. New requests have recently been received and will be presented to the Board with the 2012-13 fiscal year budget. Mr. Ortega addressed questions about the bench desk being provided for a Finance staff member.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve the Decision Packages listed on Exhibit A. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

### **County Sheriff**

9. Approve companion agreements 11-AZDOHS-OPSG-888421-01 and 11-AZDOHS-OPSG-888421-02 both with a term of October 1, 2011 through March 31, 2013, between the Sheriff's Office and the Arizona Department of Homeland Security for the Sheriff's Office to participate in Operation Stone Garden; the agreement ending in numbers 01 provides \$672,232 in overtime, ERE, and mileage reimbursement and the agreement ending in numbers 02 provides \$195,300 to purchase ten (10) sets of night vision units, thirty (30) P-25 mobile radios, and thirty (30) P-25 portable radios.

Lt. Ken Buckner, Sheriff's Office, presented this item. Lt. Buckner explained that these agreements were between the Department of Homeland Security and the Sheriff's Office to provide overtime payment to Sheriff's deputies to deal with interdiction and apprehension of drug smuggling operations in unincorporated areas of the county. He responded to the Board questions about the allocation of overtime and duties performed under the Stone Garden grant.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve companion agreements 11-AZDOHS-OPSG-888421-01 and 11-AZDOHS-OPSG-888421-02 both with a term of October 1, 2011 through March 31, 2013, between the Sheriff's Office and the Arizona Department of Homeland Security for the Sheriff's Office to participate in Operation Stone Garden; the agreement ending in numbers 01 provides \$672,232 in overtime, ERE, and mileage reimbursement and the agreement ending in numbers 02 provides \$195,300 to purchase ten (10) sets of night vision units, thirty (30) P-25 mobile radios, and thirty (30) P-25 portable radios. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote to table the item and it carried 3-0.

## **STATE & FEDERAL LEGISLATION**

Discussion and possible action regarding state and federal legislative matters, including but not limited to the items in the attached agenda.

County Supervisors Association Legislative Policy Committee Agenda for February 24, 2012 and the Executive Budget and House Budget Proposal (*see attached*).

Supervisor English reported that there is a bill to re-adjust the retirement split between employees and counties back to 50/50 from 47/53 and reimburse employees for the additional costs paid. Since Cochise County covered the additional cost last year to hold the employees harmless the outcome of this bill will need to be watched. She also mentioned bills regarding revenue sources, sex offender registration and others of interest. Supervisor English added that the legislators in our area have done a good job of keeping Cochise County interests protected and suggested the Board send Thank You notes.

Vice-Chairman Call gave the background on water district legislation relative to the Sierra Vista sub-watershed. Four years ago there was \$250,000 that went to the organizing board that has since sunset; there is approximately \$132,000 leftover that was targeted for water conservation and education. He has contacted Senator Griffin about putting those funds back in the general fund for the originally intended use but has not heard back from her. He knows there has been some wording changes in the bill and will get the specific bill number to the Board soon.

Mr. Ortega reported that the budget situation appears to be better than hoped. The bill suggesting prisoner shift appears to be dying; good news because that would have been a \$1.1 million dollar hit. The employees' retirement split bill also calls for advance payment for next fiscal year so there will be about a \$600,000 hit. It does not appear that the reimbursement of post-conviction relief monies from the State is going to happen and there are outstanding bills of approximately \$300,000 dollars which have already been spent. Mr. Ortega will be discussing the transfer of funds to cover those costs with the Board in the near future.

No action was taken on this agenda item.

### **REPORT BY MICHAEL J. ORTEGA, COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR -- RECENT AND PENDING COUNTY MATTERS**

Mr. Ortega reminded the Board about the Work Session this afternoon with Election Officials regarding HR Policies. He met with the Pima County Medical Examiner upon notification that our Medical Examiner is retiring this June; will be bringing options to the Board shortly, but warned that costs are double the current rate. He will be attending the Cochise Combined Trust (CCT) retreat tomorrow through Friday.
