

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, APRIL 10, 2012**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, April 10, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Richard Searle, Chairman; Patrick Call, Vice-Chairman; Ann English, Supervisor; Michael Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Britt Hanson, Chief Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Katie Howard, Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Searle called the meeting to order at 10:21 a.m.

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of March 27, 2012.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve items 1-8 of the Consent Agenda. Supervisor English seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Board of Supervisors

9. Approve a new liquor license application for a series #3 (microbrewery) liquor license submitted by Mr. Sean Paul McGurk for 3 Canyons Brewery located at 7302 E Silvercreek Road, Hereford, 85615.

Ms. Katie Howard, Clerk of the Board, presented this item. Ms. Howard said the Sheriff's Office and Planning and Zoning Department have recommended approval and the Environmental Health Department notes they are working to ensure all food and health codes are in compliance prior to opening the facilities; the Treasurer's Office has noted that all property taxes are current. The applicant has paid the \$100 processing fee; there are no known formal protests and staff is recommending approval.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing. No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Searle closed the public hearing.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve a new liquor license application for a series #3 (microbrewery) liquor license submitted by Mr. Sean Paul McGurk for 3 Canyons Brewery located at 7302 E Silvercreek Road, Hereford, 85615. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

10. Approve a new liquor license application for a series #12 (restaurant) liquor license submitted by Ms. Marybeth for MBeez located at 4301 S. Hwy 92, Sierra Vista, 85635.

Ms. Katie Howard, Clerk of the Board, presented this item. Ms. Howard said the Sheriff's Office and Planning and Zoning Department have recommended approval and the Environmental Health Department notes they are working to ensure all food and health codes are in compliance prior to opening the facilities; the Treasurer's Office has confirmed that all property taxes are now current. The applicant has paid the \$100 processing fee; there are no known formal protests and staff is recommending approval.

Chairman Searle asked about the wording of the motion and Ms. Howard replied that it should be amended to include the applicant's last name which is Cox.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve a new liquor license application for a series #12 (restaurant) liquor license submitted by Ms. Marybeth Cox for MBeez located at 4301 S. Hwy 92, Sierra Vista, 85635. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing. No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Searle closed the public hearing.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Community Development

11. Adopt Resolution 12-10 authorizing the abandonment of a portion of Cactus Lane public right-of-way south of Sierra Vista.

Mr. Carlos De La Torre, Director presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation (available on the County's website). Mr. De La Torre stated that Mr. Aguirre had wanted to address the Board regarding value of property [valued at \$12,000, fee based on 50 percent of the property value (\$6,150)]. This reduction was due to the location of the property and the fact that it is fragmented. Mr. Aguirre has paid for the fee but wanted to address the Board

regarding the fee. He has had a family medical emergency and was not able to attend the hearing and requested a postponement of the item. Mr. De La Torre said staff has no issue with the abandonment and are recommending approval.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing. No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Searle closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to table the item to the next regular Board meeting on April 24th. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

ACTION

Community Development

12. Adopt Resolution 12-11 to abandon the Bachmann Springs Phase One Final Subdivision Plat, the Assurance Agreement, and the Final Plan.

Ms. Beverly Wilson, Senior Planner, presented the item using a PowerPoint presentation (available on the County's website). Ms. Wilson reviewed and displayed the location and history of the subdivision plat approvals and said staff is recommending approval of the abandonment.

Mr. Britt Hanson spoke of the extraordinary amount of time County staff has spent on this project.

Chairman Searle observed that the zoning reverted in June 2010 and so the plat is not in compliance with zoning regulations. He said Mr. Adam Baugh, Esq., of Withey Morris Law firm, has been authorized to represent the real estate development of Green Life Springs Holdings, LLC formerly known as Bachmann Springs, LLC.

Mr. Baugh stated that he has only become involved in the case in the last few weeks and is therefore requesting a 90-day continuance in order to become more familiar with the 10-year history of the case.

There was a discussion between the Board members, County Attorney Mr. Hanson, and Ms. Wilson regarding the details of the development; interaction with Bachmann Springs; and reasons why staff is recommending the abandonment.

The Board discussed the County Attorney Office's recommendation to allow the requested postponement until the next Board meeting in order to analyze the facts and Chairman Searle suggested the first meeting in May.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to table the item to the first regular May Board meeting (on May 8th). Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Human Resources

13. Approve the Cochise Combined Trust schedule of benefits and rates for FY 2012-2013.

Mr. Ortega, County Administrator presented the item. Mr. Ortega is recommending no changes as far as County or staff contribution. There is one benefit structure change to follow a preferred network for prescriptions. There are three large companies CVS, Target, and Walgreen who are non-preferred providers that would require an additional five dollar copay. He said all communities within the County have access to a preferred network pharmacy.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve the Cochise Combined Trust schedule of benefits and rates for FY 2012-2013. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Indigent Defense

14. Approve the transfer of funds in the amount of \$500,000 from General Fund Contingency Account to Indigent Defense Coordinator (IDC) budget accounts.

Mr. Michael Ortega, County Administrator, presented this item. Mr. Ortega explained that this budget shortfall is attributable to expenses incurred in two capital felony cases and one capital post-conviction relief case over the past one and one-half years and he is recommending approval.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve the transfer of funds in the amount of \$500,000 from General Fund Contingency Account to Indigent Defense Coordinator (IDC) budget accounts. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

STATE & FEDERAL LEGISLATION

Discussion and possible action regarding state and federal legislative matters, including but not limited to the items in the attached County Supervisors Association Legislative Policy Committee Agenda.

Supervisor English gave an overview of pending legislation regarding firearms in public buildings; administrative procedures bill; and post-fire/flood mitigation.

Mr. Ortega stated that after discussion with the County Supervisors Association (CSA) a letter of support was sent to the Governor's Office from the Board regarding HB2360—Flood Control Districts Immunity; it deals with after fire flooding and holding the County and districts harmless on some fronts.

No action was taken on this agenda item.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Chairman Searle opened the Call to the Public. Mr. Jack Cook addressed the Board on matters of personal concern. No one else wished to address the Board and Chairman Searle closed the Call to the Public.
