

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, MAY 22, 2012**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, May 22, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Richard Searle, Chairman; Patrick Call, Vice-Chairman; Ann English, Supervisor; Michael Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Dave Fifer, Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Searle called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

CONSENT

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve a Memorandum of Understanding between Fort Huachuca Directorate of Emergency Services and the Office of the Sheriff, Cochise County Jail, for housing military prisoners in accordance with Army Regulation 190-7 dated June 15, 2006, for a 3-year term effective May 22, 2012 - May 22, 2015 at the current Jail Per Diem rate of \$224.10 for the first day of prisoner confinement and an additional \$65.56, for each day thereafter per prisoner; this rate is subject to change in accordance to the Jail Per Diem Study, conducted on an annual basis.
2. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of May 8, 2012

Community Development

3. Approve a letter acknowledging the designation of Coordinating Agency status for Cochise County by the BLM in the preparation of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and possible land use amendments for the Southline Transmission Project.

County Attorney

4. Approve the proposed settlement of the Tax Appeal in Jerrod D. Long v. Cochise County, ST2011-000683, Assessor parcel No. 103-62-271, now pending in Arizona Tax Court, a division of the Superior Court of and for Maricopa County.

County Sheriff

5. Approve a contract between the Sheriff's Office and Deputy Sheriff Philip Hogan for the use of Deputy Hogan's drug/money detecting dog at no cost to the County, effective May 22, 2012 through April 30, 2013 at which time it may be renewed.

Court Administration

6. Approve reappointments of Superior Court Judge Pro Tempore, Donna M. Beumler, pursuant to ARS 12-141; Juvenile Court Commissioners/Judges Pro Tempore Margaret Macartney, Ann Battaglia-Roberts and Gerald F. Till, pursuant to ARS 8-231 and 12-141; and approve authorization to call upon an appropriately appointed Superior Court Judge Pro Tempore from another county in extenuating circumstances pursuant to ARS 12-144; Justice Court Precinct Five Pro Tempore, Leslie Sansone and county-wide Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore Ann S. Lund (for emergency coverage), both pursuant to ARS 22-121; and approve authorization to call upon an appropriately-appointed Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore from another county in extenuating circumstances pursuant to ARS 22-122 for the period beginning July 1, 2011 to and including June 30, 2012.

Finance

7. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers.

Warrant No. 58824-58984, 58990-58997, 59000-59002, and 59030-59236 were issued in the amount of \$1,443,270.70.

Pursuant to A.R.S. §11-217(C), the published minutes shall include all demands and warrants approved by the Board in excess of one thousand dollars except that multiple demands and warrants from a single supplier or individual under one thousand dollars whose cumulative total exceeds one thousand dollars in a single reporting period shall also be published.

Procurement

8. Approve Amendment Three to the Arizona Department of Corrections (ADC) Lease Agreement No. 090098DC for renovation improvements to the Bisbee-Douglas International Airport (BDI) water system.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve items 1 through 8 of the Consent Agenda. Supervisor English seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Item 10 was heard before Item 9.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Community Development

9. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 12-08 to approve Docket R-12-01, amending Articles 2 and 17 of the Cochise County Zoning Regulations regarding the definition and requirements for Accessory Living Quarters development.

Mr. Keith Dennis, Senior Planner, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Dennis gave a brief background on the item. He stated that this will give more flexibility for size limits and that the Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval of this item. He covered the current county regulations and requirements and the proposed amendments for size limits, owner requirements, utility specifications, and home amenities. He clarified that the Planning & Zoning Commission requested modifications regarding size and special permits and stated that staff is recommending the approval of this item.

Supervisor English asked why a square footage was set.

Mr. Dennis responded that a limit had to be set in order to avoid zoning issues and neighbor complaints.

Vice-Chairman asked why 1,100 square feet was set as the limit.

Mr. Carlos De La Torre, Community Development Director, said it was established based on average size of family home. He said since the building was separate it could not be equal to the size of the original home on the property.

Chairman Searle commended staff for making progress on outdated zoning regulations.

The Board discussed reasons why a percentage of the original building's footage should be used instead of the 1,100 square foot limit.

Supervisor English asked Mr. Fifer if the Board could make amendments to the ordinance.

Mr. Fifer and Mr. Ambrose, county attorneys, advised the Board that they had the authority to make changes since the public hearing advertisement stated what zoning regulation would be discussed at today's meeting.

Vice-Chairman Call stated that removing the 1,100 square foot limit would not be a problem since the 75% limit accomplished the same purpose as the 1,100 square foot limit.

Mr. Dennis clarified that anything more than 75% would have to go through a special use permit.

Supervisor English made a motion to amend the motion to remove the 1,100 ft limit. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion and it carried 2-1 Searle opposed.

Supervisor English revised the motion to Adopt Zoning Ordinance 12-08 to approve Docket R-12-01, amending Articles 2 and 17 of the Cochise County Zoning Regulations and adding the amendment of changing size to 75%

instead of 1,100 sq. ft., regarding the definition and requirements for Accessory Living Quarters development. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the amended motion.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing. No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Searle closed the public hearing.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

ACTION

Board of Supervisors

10. Adopt Resolution 12-14 temporarily prohibiting the use of "Permissible Consumer Fireworks" in the unincorporated areas of Cochise County; and specifying criminal penalties and financial responsibility for the violation of this prohibition.

Mr. Michael Ortega, County Administrator, presented this item. Mr. Ortega reviewed the background of the resolution and stated that the County staff is working on an ordinance for an "open fire" ban which would be presented to the Board at a later time.

Chairman Searle stated that this would ensure something is done as soon as possible.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to adopt Resolution 12-14 temporarily prohibiting the use of "Permissible Consumer Fireworks" in the unincorporated areas of Cochise County; and specifying criminal penalties and financial responsibility for the violation of this prohibition. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

11. Approve an IGA between Pima County and Cochise County for Medical Examiner Services for a five-year term effective May 22, 2012 - May 22, 2017 at an annual rate of \$350,000 paid quarterly.

Mr. Michael Ortega, County Administrator, presented this item. Mr. Ortega stated that the main reason to go into an agreement with Pima County for this service was because Dr. Flores retired and could no longer provide the service for the County. He explained that the medical examiner usually decided whether or not an autopsy is needed. He stated that the agreement was based on 300 deaths, the average per year in Cochise County, and that if the number changed the agreement would be revised.

Vice-Chairman Call stated that under the circumstances entering in an agreement with Pima County was the best choice.

Supervisor English commended Mr. Ortega on his ability to find someone so quickly to take over medical examiner services.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve an IGA between Pima County and Cochise County for Medical Examiner Services for a five-year term effective May 22, 2012 - May 22, 2017 at an annual rate of \$350,000 paid quarterly. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Health & Social Services

12. Approve four new Health Educator positions for a new First Things First program in anticipation of a grant approval funding notice in June, 2012 from the Arizona Department of Health Services to Cochise Health & Social Services in the amount of \$287,439.

Ms. Mary Gomez, Health & Social Services Director, presented this item. Ms. Gomez stated that the request was unusual because her department is requesting approval of the grant before the grant is actually given by the State. She explained the County could not do recruitments for the positions before being mandated to provide services which will be needed within 30 days of grant approval. She reviewed the types of services provided by the grant and listed the locations of the County covered under this grant; Benson, Bisbee, and Willcox. Ms. Gomez said she felt confident about being the recipient of the grant.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve four new Health Educator positions for a new First Things First program in anticipation of a grant approval funding notice in June, 2012 from the Arizona Department of Health Services to Cochise Health & Social Services in the amount of \$287,439. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

REPORT BY MICHAEL J. ORTEGA, COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR -- RECENT AND PENDING COUNTY MATTERS

Mr. Ortega reported that he has spent the last several weeks had been going through the budget process and is expecting one more work session in June for Solid Waste Management.

Chairman Searle opened the Call to the Public.

Mr. Jack Cook addressed the Board on matters of personal concern. No one else wished to address the Board and Chairman Searle closed the Call to the Public.
