

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, AUGUST 14, 2012**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, August 14, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Richard Searle, Chairman; Patrick Call, Vice-Chairman; Ann English, Supervisor; Michael Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Britt Hanson, Chief Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Katie Howard, Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Searle called the meeting to order at 10:15 a.m.

ROLL CALL – Richard Searle, Ann English present; Supervisor Call joined the meeting telephonically during discussion of Item 21.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Chairman Searle opened the Call to the Public.

Ms. Sarah Traum spoke to the Board about the community concerns of South Bisbee and Freeport McMoran's request for them to leave the area by year's end. She stated that the residents have collected over 800 signatures on petition and presented to Freeport McMoran and they did not respond. They are requesting time extension to June 2013.

Ms. Linda Barnett read several statements by the residents of South Bisbee.

Mr. Jack Cook addressed the matter on personal concerns. No one else wished to address the Board and Chairman Searle closed the Call to the Public.

PRESENTATION

Presentation by Ms. Kathy Boyle and Mr. Bill Harmon, Arizona Department of Transportation: The Future of Transportation in Arizona, using a PowerPoint presentation & video.

Ms. Kathy Boyle stated that the community outreach meetings were part of a three year outreach program to let stakeholders know about future projects in the area, discuss role of transportation in job creation, and discuss funding for these projects. Mr. Bill Harmon, District Engineer, discussed local projects and gave details about each project along with projected start and completion dates.

Health

18. Approve Professional Services Agreement (PSA) No. 12-21-HEA-03 with Copper Queen Community Hospital for Jail and Juvenile Detainee Hospital Services for the Cochise County Health Department in the estimated amount of \$200,000 for the period of August 1, 2012 through July 31, 2013.

Workforce Development

19. Approve Amendment #8 to Title IB Adult, Youth, and Dislocated Worker Contract DE111004001 between Cochise County and the Arizona Department of Economic Security for the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Service Delivery Area from April 1, 2010 to August 31, 2015.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve items 1-19 of the Consent Agenda. Chairman Searle seconded the motion and it carried 2-0-1; Call absent.

Supervisor English read the Proclamation re: Child Support Awareness Month aloud, declaring August 2012 to be Child Support Awareness month and introduced Mr. Scott Lekan, Arizona Division of Child Support Enforcement, to whom she presented the Proclamation.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Board of Supervisors

20. Approve an agent change/acquisition of control liquor license application for a series #12 (restaurant) liquor license submitted by Mr. John H. Campagne for Mesquite Tree located at 6398 S Hwy 92, Hereford, 85615.

Ms. Katie Howard, Clerk of the Board, presented this item. Ms. Howard said the Sheriff's Office and Planning and Zoning Department have recommended approval and the Environmental Health Division noted that the establishment meets all the requirements set forth by the Arizona Food Code; the Treasurer's Office has noted that all property taxes are current. The applicant has paid the \$100 processing fee; there are no known formal protests and staff is recommending approval.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing. No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Searle closed the public hearing.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve an agent change/acquisition of control liquor license application for a series #12 (restaurant) liquor license submitted by Mr. John H. Campagne for Mesquite Tree located at 6398 S Hwy 92, Hereford, 85615. Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote; approved 2-0-1; Call absent.

Community Development

21. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 12-10 to approve Docket R-12-02, amending the Cochise County Zoning Regulations for agricultural uses, and codifying definitions and site development standards for those uses, as set forth in Exhibit.

Mr. Michael Turisk, Planning Manager, Community Development, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Turisk explained the proposed changes to Agricultural definitions and regulations in the County Zoning Regulations to promote and support agriculture industry and to encourage agri-tourism. He reviewed proposed changes to definitions designed to comply with state law and to provide regulatory relief to these agricultural uses. Staff is also proposing a new use related to domestic wineries. He reviewed the four zoning districts and described the impact of these proposed changes and in particular the setback requirements to the Board and stated that the Planning & Zoning Commission voted unanimously to approve, with one change (which he described). He said that staff recommends approval.

Supervisor English commented that this is a rural community and encouraged fewer regulations to keep family farms intact (encouraging domestic production as opposed to importing food produced elsewhere).

Chairman Searle commended staff for their work on this project. He explained the driving factors for determining the relative offsite impacts from on-site agricultural processing, depending on parcel size. He stated that he had a

proposal: instead of calling it "on site agricultural processing services" (recited definition), he said he would like to add "for administrative permitting purposes..." – to change the protocol.

Mr. Hanson stated that he thought the language might work to accomplish what the County is trying to accomplish (i.e., no permit for onsite agricultural processing),

Supervisor Call joined the meeting telephonically.

Chairman Searle also suggested adding wine-tasting rooms to section 6.3 (so they would fall under agricultural processing) and he also wanted to keep setback requirements but remove permit requirement.

Mr. Turisk stated that this would be a fairly significant change and would have to go back to the Planning and Zoning Commission. Mr. Hanson recommended the item be tabled; however, he stated that it did not need to go back to the Planning and Zoning Commission for review.

Supervisor English made a motion to table the item; Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion and Mr. Ortega pointed out that it could be tabled to the special meeting for the upcoming week. The Board concurred.

Chairman Searle also discussed the setback requirements in section 603.17 and then recapped the items for staff to review and revise.

Chairman Searle called for the vote on the motion to table the item; approved 3-0.

22. Adopt Resolution 12-33 to approve Docket TUP-12-01, a request for a Temporary Use Permit requiring Board approval for the Western Junction Bar & Grill, Parcel 103-88-002B, located at 5838 Double Adobe Road in McNeal, AZ.

Mr. Keith Dennis, Senior Planner, Community Development, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation, explaining why this Temporary Use Permit requires a public hearing under the P&Z regulations. He stated that the applicant plans numerous special events and has applied for a special use permit which will be considered by the Planning and Zoning Commission at a meeting in September to avoid having to repeatedly apply for a Temporary Use Permit.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing. No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Searle closed the public hearing.

Supervisor English made a motion to adopt Resolution 12-33 to approve Docket TUP-12-01, a request for a Temporary Use Permit requiring Board approval for the Western Junction Bar & Grill, Parcel 103-88-002B, located at 5838 Double Adobe Road in McNeal, AZ. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote; approved 3-0.

ACTION

Board of Supervisors

23. Approve submission of the attached legislative proposals to the County Supervisors Association (CSA) for consideration to be included in the CSA legislative platform.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve submission of the attached legislative proposals to the County Supervisors Association (CSA) for consideration to be included in the CSA legislative platform. Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Ms. Karen Riggs, Interim Director, Community Development presented this item. Ms. Riggs explained that there are two proposals for consideration. She reviewed them: First proposal was to strike language that gives county supervisors back control of county highways, but commented that the Arizona county engineers felt that such an attempt would not be successful. Second proposal was to remedy inconsistencies between two state statutes. The changes proposed would remove the requirement that a road being built to county standards must be in a platted subdivision and would allow any road built to county standards to be brought into county maintained system.

Supervisor English stated that in order to garner support at the CSA conference these needed to be explained clearly and quickly.

Chairman Searle said that roads created prior to 1990 are not declared primitive now, but said they could be if the proposals are successful. He asked what the outcome for last year's proposal on the limitation of Flood Control District expenditures was. Ms. Karen Riggs stated that Pinal County proposed using formal agreements between the counties to remedy this limitation.

Chairman Searle called for the vote; approved 3-0.

24. Adopt Resolution 12-36, approving an extension of The Red Hawk II Units 2 & 3 Subdivision Assurance Agreement with Title Security Agency, Inc. an Arizona Corporation, as Trustee under trust number 963 to a date of July 11, 2014.

Supervisor English made a motion to adopt Resolution 12-36, approving an extension of The Red Hawk II Units 2 & 3 Subdivision Assurance Agreement with Title Security Agency, Inc. an Arizona Corporation, as Trustee under trust number 963 to a date of July 11, 2014. Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Mr. Mike Turisk, Planning Manager, Community Development, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Turisk explained that RHII & III subdivision is 192 lot subdivision south of I10-and east & west of J-6 Ranch Road. He showed map of subdivision with phases 2 & 3 outlined in green. He explained that staff recommended approving the assurance agreement due to the economy, and said that staff did an administrative extension 2-3 years ago; the original agreement was approved in 2007.

Chairman Searle called for the vote; approved 3-0.

25. Adopt Resolution 12-37, approving an extension of The Sonora Verde Subdivision Assurance Agreement with Fidelity National Title Agency, Inc. as Trustee under trust number 10353 to a date of May 17, 2014.

Supervisor English made a motion to adopt Resolution 12-37, approving an extension of The Sonora Verde Subdivision Assurance Agreement with Fidelity National Title Agency, Inc. as Trustee under trust number 10353 to a date of May 17, 2014. Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Mr. Turisk, Community Development, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Turisk stated that the subdivision was approved in the 1980s for 43 lots; 6 remaining. He said that the project was revived in 2005 for 18 lots and that the assurance agreement expired May 17, 2011 so the applicant requested an extension for May 17, 2014, citing economic concerns. He said staff recommends approval.

Chairman Searle asked what improvements remained. Mr. Joe Schnieder, president of Sonora Ventures said the project is 90% complete and that some water issues were being resolved with Pomerene Water District.

Chairman Searle called for the vote; approved 3-0.

Health & Social Services

26. Approve a Memorandum of Understanding between Cochise Health and Social Services (CHSS) and Chiricahua Community Health Centers, Inc. to share space in the Sierra Vista Foothills office and parking lot and space in the parking lot at Melody Lane complex near building A.

Ms. Mary Gomez, Health & Social Services Director, presented this item. Ms. Gomez explained that this MOU establishes a formal collaboration with one of their strategic partners to share space with Chiricahua Mobile Health Clinic (parking, lobby & restrooms) at the Foothills Center 1 day per week, which would be on same day Health Dept. is providing child immunizations. She reviewed the rest of the agreement and stated that this would be a great way to provide collaboration with health partners for the benefit of the public.

Vice-Chairman Call commented on parking areas at Foothills being used by Border Patrol and by the County, now. He suggested intermediate trial basis initially to try out idea. Ms. Gomez clarified that there is a 14-60 day notice provision in the agreement and explained that the term of the agreement is for 1 year, with 2 two-year automatic renewals.

The Board directed Mr. Ortega to follow up with Border patrol regarding parking. Ms. Gomez was directed to bring back agreement for renewals; they should not be automatic.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve a Memorandum of Understanding between Cochise Health and Social Services (CHSS) and Chiricahua Community Health Centers, Inc. to share space in the Sierra Vista Foothills office

and parking lot and space in the parking lot at Melody Lane complex near building A. Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote; approved 3-0.

27. Approve the new subcontract, First Things First – Parents as Teachers, between the Easter Seals Blake Foundation and Cochise Health & Social Services, in the amount of \$287,439, for the period of 7/1/12 to 6/30/13.

Ms. Marilyn Godfrey, Director of Health Start program, presented this item. She stated that the Health Start program has been in place for over 15 years to reduce health risks for term of pregnancy and first two years of child's life. She informed the Board that 3,000 families were currently in the target population and that they were looking for a way to expand services to this population. Cochise Health Services proposed a new program and received the award that will allow expanding services to 200 additional families. She stated that the partnership will reduce duplicated services and is 100% grant funded; the sub contract amount is \$287,439.

Supervisor English made a motion to approve the new subcontract, First Things First – Parents as Teachers, between the Easter Seals Blake Foundation and Cochise Health & Social Services, in the amount of \$287,439, for the period of 7/1/12 to 6/30/13. Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote; approved 3-0.

REPORT BY MICHAEL J. ORTEGA, COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR -- RECENT AND PENDING COUNTY MATTERS

Mr. Ortega reported that he will be meeting with County Managers Association on Friday to discuss legislative proposals. One proposal is to change language back on abandonments and border traffic patterns on the Arizona/Mexico border.
