Dear Honorable Ward;

I would like to be considered for the constable vacancy for JP4 and upon inquiring regarding the filling of this vacancy I have been directed by Mr. Searle to set up an appointment with you, Mr. Searle and myself to discuss the position, responsibilities, qualifications and the consideration of the need for the vacancy to be filled at this time.

I personally feel that positions vacated prior to the expiration of the elected term should be replaced with a competent appointment to finish serving out the length of the remaining term as to fulfill the community's right to have each position represented within the appropriate level of the governmental position. The justice system operates most effectively when the responsibilities of each position are tended to by the properly trained elected or appointed officials. I feel that my educational background in the legal field, previous employment (most recently as the Paralegal at The Allred Law Office) and my current leadership training as one of 20 participants chosen to for the Project CENTRL class XXI leadership training program; combined with my understanding of the legal and court systems make me an excellent choice to honorably fill the current vacancy in JP 4 as Constable. I understand that there is a training course for this position when it is filled, and I am able to attend the training that is required upon accepting such an appointment and assuming the responsibilities of the position.

So at this time I respectfully request an appointment to meet with you and Mr. Searle and submit to both you and Mr. Searle, my interest in being appointed to fill the vacant Constable position for the Justice Court in Willcox. I will arrange my schedule so that I will be available to meet with you at your earliest convenience, to discuss this matter further. Due to the

upcoming election deadlines for applicants for other various civic service opportunities, I would ask that a meeting and decision regarding the appointment to fill the Constable vacancy be made in a timely fashion so that if I am not selected to be appointed to fill the Constable vacancy, I may continue to pursue a seat on the governing board of the Willcox Unified School Board.
