

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2012**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, October 23, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Richard Searle, Chairman; Patrick Call, Vice-Chairman; Ann English, Supervisor; Michael Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Britt Hanson, Chief Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Searle called the meeting to order at 10:04 a.m.

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meetings of the Board of Supervisors of October 9, 2012.
2. Approve a liquor license application for a series 16 (Wine Festival/Wine Fair) submitted by Mr. Rod Keeling for Keeling-Schaefer Vineyards for a Wine Festival to be held at 155 N Frontage Road, Pearce, 85625 on November 10, 2012.
3. Approve the issuance of the replacement tax refund check in the amount of \$429.63 to Judith Mikeal of St. David, AZ.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve items 1-6 of the Consent Agenda. Supervisor English seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Board of Supervisors

7. Approve a new liquor license application for a series #10 (beer & wine store) liquor license submitted by Mr. Rodney S. Herbert for Super Stop located at 5620 S. Hwy 92 in Hereford, 85615.

Ms. Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board presented this item. Ms. Rios said the Sheriff's Office and Planning and Zoning Department have recommended approval and the Environmental Health Division noted that the establishment meets all the requirements set forth by the Arizona Food Code; the Treasurer's Office has noted that all property taxes are current. The applicant has paid the \$100 processing fee; the Board office has received one petition and one letter from citizens around the area opposed and one petition in favor of this liquor license.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing.

Mr. Robert Maloney, a citizen of Hereford was opposed to the liquor license and not the actual convenient store. He said that he was opposed because of the proliferation of liquor licenses in the area. Mr. Maloney brought signed petitions from citizens in Hereford opposing the liquor license and said that although citizens supported new businesses in the area they were opposed to another liquor license.

Mr. Tim Bullington, representative of Country Estates Baptist Church, read a letter from the pastor. He said that the congregation voted unanimously to oppose another liquor license in the area. Mr. Bullington stated that he is also a realtor and supports new businesses in Hereford, but is opposed to another liquor license.

Chairman Searle closed the Call to the Public.

Mr. Thomas Aguilera, representative for Ray's Ranch Investors, stated that the liquor license in question did not violate any proximity statutes to churches or schools in the area. He said that his client, Mr. Rodney Herbert, is the controlling agent for 40 licenses in Arizona and has a stellar record. Mr. Aguilera said that the Board approved a series 10 liquor license at this location in 2007 as part of the permit application to build the convenient store. He added that Ray's Ranch Investors has made several improvements to the area and they were committed to continue to be good neighbors to the citizens of Hereford.

Mr. Rodney Herbert, owner of Super Stop, provided the Board with more original petitions in support of the liquor license. He stated he currently operates 40 convenience stores in Arizona and eight of those are in Cochise County. Mr. Herbert said that operating a convenience store without a liquor license was not profitable. He assured the Board that proper steps to ensure security had been taken and that his staff had gone through the proper liquor handling training.

Vice-Chairman Call stated that this liquor license has a permitted use and that although he understood proliferation concerns he did not have a problem approving the liquor license.

Chairman Searle asked what the difference was between a series 9 and series 10 liquor license.

Mr. Herbert said that a series 10 was strictly for beer and wine not hard liquor.

Supervisor English stated that although the Board had a responsibility to the community and understood proliferation concerns, she sympathized with business etiquette and saw no reason to disapprove the liquor license application.

Chairman Call moved to approve a new liquor license application for a series #10 (beer & wine store) liquor license submitted by Mr. Rodney S. Herbert for Super Stop located at 5620 S. Hwy 92 in Hereford, 85615. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

8. Approve a new liquor license application for a series #10 (beer & wine store) liquor license submitted by Mr. David W. Thompson for PJ's Travel Center located at 1275 Business Loop 366 & I10 Bowie, 85605.

Ms. Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board presented this item. Ms. Rios said the Sheriff's Office and Planning and Zoning Department have recommended approval and the Environmental Health Division noted that the establishment meets all the requirements set forth by the Arizona Food Code; the Treasurer's Office has noted that the property taxes for the location are not current. The applicant has paid the \$100 processing fee; there are no known formal protests.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing. No one else wished to address the Board and Chairman Searle closed the Call to the Public.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve a new liquor license application for a series #10 (beer & wine store) liquor license submitted by Mr. David W. Thompson for PJ's Travel Center located at 1275 Business Loop 366 & I10 Bowie, 85605. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Mr. Ortega said that this line of credit is done on an annual basis.

Supervisor English made a motion to adopt Resolution 12-77 approving the form and authorizing the execution and delivery of a Line of Credit agreement for Cochise County between the Treasurer of Cochise County and J.P. Morgan Chase Bank ratifying all actions taken to date with respect to the Line of Credit Agreement. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle asked about other line of credit agreements for the other districts.

Mr. Ortega stated that this was a little different than the line of credits established for the different districts in the county.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.
