

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 27, 2012**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, November 27, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Richard Searle, Chairman; Patrick Call, Vice-Chairman; Ann English, Supervisor; Michael Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Dave Fifer, Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Searle called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

ROLL CALL – All three supervisors present.

PRESENTATION

Ms. Judy Gilligan, Preventive Services Director, gave a brief description of the recognition from the state for different preventative programs and how counties can qualify for these awards. She said that Cochise County had received 3 of the 15 awards given out by the State.

Chairman Searle presented certificates to Ana Maria Flannigan, Lee Itule, Jesus Duarte, Beth Anderson, Beverly Eskue, and Suzanne Hagle from the Health & Social Services Department for their outstanding efforts in making the Tobacco & Chronic Disease Prevention Program the head of the pack in the State of Arizona.

CONSENT

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meetings of the Board of Supervisors of November 13, 2012.
2. Approve the Annual Joint Funding Agreement (JFA No. 2) with United States Geological Survey (USGS) in the amount of \$56,900 for the period of October 1, 2012 to September 30, 2013 to conduct hydrological investigations and data collection.

7. Approve a new liquor license application for a series #7 and #12 (beer & wine bar and restaurant) liquor license submitted by Mr. Daniel A. Wood for Shadow Mountain Golf Course/Country Club located at 1105 Irene Street in Pearce, 85625.

Ms. Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board presented this item. Ms. Rios said the Sheriff's Office and Planning and Zoning Department have recommended approval and the Environmental Health Division noted that the establishment meets all the requirements set forth by the Arizona Food Code; the Treasurer's Office has noted that all property taxes are current. The applicant has paid the \$100 processing fee; the Board staff recommended approval.

8. Approve Grant Number 20132162, Unwasted Weekend Project, between the Cochise Community Foundation and Cochise County Health and Social Services in the amount of \$1,500 for the period of 10/01/2012 to 9/30/2013.

This item was presented by Ms. Suzanne Hagle, Health Administrative Manager, Health and Social Services. Ms. Hagle stated that the Unwasted Weekend Project is a campaign that was started by the Music TV Channel to bring high school teens together to have a fun weekend and not participate in risky behavior. The Health Department and the youth collation group will implement this program next year. She said the event will be held sometime in the spring in Douglas and teens from all over the county will be invited.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve Grant Number 20132162, Unwasted Weekend Project, between the Cochise Community Foundation and Cochise County Health and Social Services in the amount of \$1,500 for the period of 10/01/2012 to 9/30/2013. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

9. Adopt Resolution No. 12-78 to establish a schedule of fees for STD Testing Services provided by Cochise Health & Social Services for testing, education, screening and treatment of clients for sexually transmitted diseases, effective on and after January 1, 2013.
