

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

Attached is a list of incidents, ten in total, that have occurred at the Mescal Bar and Grill over the past five years. Please note that the most recent significant event is still an active investigation. During this incident one person received fatal injuries by being run over by a vehicle during, or after, a physical altercation between the parties.

Also please note that the Sheriff's Office is not recommending either approval or disapproval of the application.

Incidents responded to by CCSO in the last 5 years:

07/2007	07-20032	Responded to the bar for a person being threatened. Investigation indicated that "bikers" may have been responsible for threats being issued.
01/2008	08-01701	Responded to a 911 call regarding a person who was refusing to leave the bar, was intoxicated and that weapons were possibly involved. Received a call from the bartender indicating that a response was no longer needed as it was an employee issue.
02/2008	08-02604	Responded to a report of an assault with injuries. Investigation indicated that a female was assaulted by a male patron inside the bar. The male patron was assaulted in retaliation for the attack on the female. The male suspect then rammed his vehicle into the pillars supporting the porch of the bar causing damage to the building.
06/2008	08-10844	Responded to a 911 call of a disorderly subject inside the bar. Subject was asked to leave and was pushed by a bar patrol after he became disorderly.
09/2008	08-16877	A vehicle was stolen from the parking lot of the bar.
09/2009	09-17195	Physical Assault with injury between two intoxicated parties in the parking lot.
09/2009	09-17181	Medical call; subject dislocated his knee while participating in a beer keg throwing contest during a motorcycle show/gathering.
08/2010	10-14727	Responded to a citizen complaining that a woman was washing motorcycles topless in the parking lot on the east side of the building during a motorcycle rally/gathering. Deputies responded and confirmed the complaint, warnings were issued
09/2010	10-16560	Responded to a report of two "motorcycle dudes looking as if they are going to fight". Deputies had negative contact with any disturbance upon arrival.
12/2011	11-20079	Responded to an accident with fatal injuries. Investigation revealed that a physical assault occurred in the parking lot between multiple subjects, one subject was fatally injured off of the bar property
