



## PRIMARY ELECTION

AUGUST 28, 2012

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Primary Election was held on August 29, 2012, the 49 election precincts established with redistricting were utilized. There were no significant issues with voters locating the correct precinct.

There were two incidents in which the police were called to the polling location. In Bisbee (#6 BI Warren) a candidate refused to stop campaigning within the 75 foot limit. In Sierra Vista (#29 Carmelita) one of the poll workers removed a candidate sign that was outside of the 75 foot limit. Both issues were resolved without further incident. Future education of the poll workers will include information on candidate signage dos and don'ts.

At precinct #41 Village Meadows, a Spanish speaking only voter presented and there was not a poll worker who could translate. The polling location contact the Elections office by phone and staff was able to translate over the phone and resolve the voter's concerns. To avoid future situations the elections department will work to obtain additional Spanish speaking poll workers in the Sierra Vista area.

There was one equipment failure involving a M100. The troubleshooter replaced the machine at precinct #11 Castro Park in Douglas. Voting was not interrupted during this time period. Precincts were able to use the central sending location to modem results to the Elections Department. There was an issue with modem of results from the central Bisbee location. The IT department is working on resolving this issue.

Both the Republican and Democratic Parties participated in the hand count and early ballot audit that was conducted on August 29, 2012. There were no discrepancies identified during the hand count and early ballot audit. Those results are included in the report and have been submitted to the Secretary of State.
