

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, JANUARY 8, 2013**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, January 8, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Richard Searle, Chairman; Patrick Call, Vice-Chairman; Ann English, Supervisor; Michael Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Dave Fifer, Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Searle called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Chairman Searle removed item 9 from the consent agenda at his request.

ROLL CALL – All three supervisors present.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Chairman Searle opened the Call to the Public.

No one wished to address the Board and Chairman Searle closed the Call to the Public.

CONSENT

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of December 18, 2012.

Court Administration

2. Approve the Judicial Funding Agreements for fiscal year 2012-2013 in the amount of \$3,694,507 as set forth in the attached exhibit.

Emergency Services

3. Accept Homeland Security grants in the aggregate amount of \$9,500: Homeland Security grant for \$2,500 for training, Homeland Security grant for \$2,500 for exercise, Homeland Security grant for \$2,500 for planning; Homeland Security grant for \$2,000 for Citizen Corps.

Finance

4. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers.

Warrant No. 66052-66622, 66228, 66256-66356, 66363-66442 were issued in the amount of \$819,533.41.

Pursuant to A.R.S. §11-217(C), the published minutes shall include all demands and warrants approved by the Board in excess of one thousand dollars except that multiple demands and warrants from a single supplier or individual under one thousand dollars whose cumulative total exceeds one thousand dollars in a single reporting period shall also be published.

Fleet

5. Approve the sale of a 1992 Bronco T120 Road Power Broom, declared surplus by the Fleet Management Department, to the City of Benson in the amount of \$1,000.

Health

6. Approve the renewal of IGA# ADHS 13-0345334, Reproductive Health (previously IGA# HG854245), between the Arizona Department of Health Services and Cochise Health & Social Services, with a maximum billable amount of \$49,600.00, funded annually, for the five year period of 1/1/13 to 12/31/17.

7. Approve the renewal to IGA# ADHS12-022007, Proposition 201 Smoke Free Arizona Act (previously IGA# HG752220), between the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) and Cochise Health & Social Services (CHSS). The maximum billable amount under this contract is currently \$69,807, funded annually. This contract renewal is for the five year period of 7/1/12 to 6/30/17.

8. Approve renewal of IGA# ADHS13-034429, Teen Pregnancy Prevention Program (previously HG861229), between the Arizona Department of Health Services and Cochise Health & Social Services, in the amount of \$136,414 annually, for the period of January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2017.

9. Approve a Memorandum of Understanding between Fry's Food Store in Sierra Vista and Cochise County for the purpose of providing mass distribution of vaccinations or medications in the event of a disaster or emergency to Fry's employees and their families, utilizing a closed point of dispensing method.

10. Approve a Memorandum of Understanding between Copper Queen Community Hospital and Cochise Health & Social Services regarding a drug discount program effective 1/8/2013 and to continue indefinitely.

Vice-Chairman Call made a motion to approve items 1-8 and 10 of the Consent Agenda. Supervisor English seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Board of Supervisors

11. Adopt Ordinance 13-01, approving Docket Z-12-07, conditionally amending the zoning district designation for Parcels 119-05-244 through 252, from SR-43 to RU-4, pursuant to the application of Mr. Michael Jantz.

Mr. Keith Dennis, Planner II, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Dennis gave the background, showed the location of the property and stated that there were letters in support and in opposition. He said that most of those in opposition were worried about the impact of the rezoning on property values for the area. Mr. Dennis stated that both the Planning and Zoning Commission and staff recommended approval.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing. No one chose to speak. Chairman Searle closed the Call to the Public.

Supervisor English moved to adopt Zoning Ordinance 13-01, approving Docket Z-12-07, conditionally amending the zoning district designation for Parcels 119-05-244 through 252, from SR-43 to RU-4, pursuant to the application of Mr. Michael Jantz. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Facilities

12. Present information and hold first of two Public Hearings for FY 2013 Community Development Block Grant Application Process for Cochise County to receive public input and to identify community needs in Cochise County.

Ms. Lisa Marra, Grants Administrator, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Marra explained that this is the first of two hearings and stated that she had only received one request since publishing the information countywide. She also said that this year the amount available would be \$170,000 and that the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) was strongly recommending for each entity to submit one project.

Chairman Searle asked if the entire amount was for Cochise County's use or if it would be distributed to other entities as well.

Ms. Marra said that the entire amount was for the County.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing. No one chose to speak. Chairman Searle closed the Call to the Public.

Chairman Searle said that Bowie was interested in submitting a project for a community building and asked that a work session be scheduled before the next hearing.

Health

13. Adopt Resolution 13-01 to establish a schedule of fees for STD Testing Services provided by Cochise Health & Social Services for testing, education, screening and treatment of clients for sexually transmitted diseases, effective on and after February 11, 2013.

Ms. Radi Ann Porter, Director of Nursing, presented this item. Ms. Porter explained that the funding from the State had decreased over time and not charging for this type of testing would mean the program would not be able to continue. She said that people under 19 years of age would not have to pay and that there would be a sliding scale to accommodate people with different incomes. Ms. Porter stated that the fee proposal was based on fees charged currently in other counties and that although the fee schedule would not turn a profit or even completely support the program it would keep it going.

Chairman Searle said that a sliding scale would be good since fees might deter some people from getting tested.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing. No one chose to speak. Chairman Searle closed the Call to the Public.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to adopt Resolution 13-01 to establish a schedule of fees for STD Testing Services provided by Cochise Health & Social Services for testing, education, screening and treatment of clients for sexually transmitted diseases, effective on and after February 11, 2013. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

ACTION

Board of Supervisors

14. Elect Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, effective February 1, 2013.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to elect Supervisor Ann English as Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, effective February 1, 2013. Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

15. Elect as Vice-Chairman to the Board of Supervisors, effective February 1, 2013.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to elect Chairman Richard Searle as Vice-Chairman to the Board of Supervisors, effective February 1, 2013. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Community Development

16. Approve the waiver of Building Permit fees of \$80.00 for the construction of a residential porch for Mr. Billy M. Brown.

Mr. Keith Dennis, Planner II, presented this item. He stated that in 2009 a policy was approved by the Board that allows a citizen to petition for a waiver of permit fees directly to the Board. Mr. Dennis said that due to the delicacy of this request staff did not have a recommendation.

Chairman Searle said that he read the request letter from Mr. Brown.

Vice-Chairman Call requested a work session with staff to review policy in detail.

Mr. Ortega stated that he would schedule the work session.

Supervisor English said that although she understood some citizens needed support, she did not think waiving fees was the proper action. She stated that we should be referring these citizens to organizations that specialize in helping those with limited income.

Supervisor English moved to approve the waiver of Building Permit fees of \$80.00 for the construction of a residential porch for Mr. Billy M. Brown. No second.

Motion fails for lack of second.
