

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 26, 2013**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, February 26, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Ann English, Chairman; Richard Searle, Vice-Chairman; Patrick Call, Supervisor; Mike Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Britt Hanson, Chief Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board.

Chairman English called the meeting to order at 10:09 a.m.

ROLL CALL – All three supervisors present.

Chairman English stated the Community Development Department has requested that Item 5 be removed from the agenda.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Chairman English opened the Call to the Public.

Jack Cook addressed the Board on matters of personal concern.

Mr. Winston Whitman addressed the Board on Agenda 21, a United Nations website addressing global warming.

No one else wished to address the Board and Chairman English closed the Call to the Public.

CONSENT

Chairman English removed Item 1 from the consent agenda for discussion and action.

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve a letter of support for the Greater Sierra Vista area Metropolitan Planning Organization.

Ms. Jere Fredenburgh addressed the Board with her concerns regarding the new Greater Sierra Vista Metropolitan Planning Organization Board. She said that she did not understand why a new board was formed when another organization already existed to address transportation plans in the County.

Chairman English stated that Sierra Vista was mandated to start this new board due to the population increase from the 2010 census.

Mr. Dan Coxworth, Senior Planner, City of Sierra Vista, said that the City of Sierra Vista had met on the topic several times and hosted public meetings to notify affected citizens. He explained that the board would consist of representatives from all interested parties and clarified that the board does have bylaws they have to abide by and an extensive public input process to ensure everyone is aware of the planning process.

Mr. Douglas Behnke expressed his concerns about the MPO and said that insufficient documents on the structure of the MPO were provided to the public.

Mr. Coxworth stated that the board is mandated and has laws that define its purpose and if not formed there would be financial penalties for the City of Sierra Vista, which would mean that federal transportation money could not be used in the area. He noted that the MPO does not have any more power than the County and was strictly a planning organization that does not build or do anything except for planning.

Supervisor Call moved to approve letter of support for the Greater Sierra Vista area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Board of Supervisors

2. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of February 12, 2013.

Community Development

3. Approve the appointment of Mr. Anastacio (Andy) Salaiz to the Board of Adjustment, District 2, for a term ending December 31, 2014.

Finance

4. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers.

Warrants Nos. 67322-67348, 67355-67482, 67486-67520, 67522-67638 were issued in the amount of \$946,525.75.

Vice-Chairman Searle made a motion to approve items 2-4 of the Consent Agenda. Supervisor Call seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Chairman English stated that there were several citizens in attendance that wanted to discuss this item.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Community Development

This item was removed from the agenda.

5. Adopt Resolution 13-04 to approve Docket H-13-01, a request to place a lien on Parcel 106-39-151, located at 504 E. Yuma Street in Huachuca City, to recover the costs of abating a Public Nuisance, in the amount of \$16,905.

Facilities

6. Present information and hold the second of two Public Hearings for Fiscal Year 2013 Community Development Block Grant Application (CDBG) process for Cochise County to receive public input and to identify community needs in Cochise County.

This item was presented by Lisa Marra using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Marra stated that it was the second public hearing as required and reviewed the background of the grant. She read the list of possible projects and added two more projects submitted by St. David and Sierra Vista.

Supervisor Call asked which projects were eligible for the grant.

Ms. Marra said the following projects qualified: Elfrida Water District Improvements, Fry Fire Electrical Upgrades, Bowie Water District Improvements, Bowie Fire District Structure and Landing Zone, Bowie Fire District Blood Pressure Monitor, Bay Acres Sewer Connections, Emergency Home Repair, St. David Water District Line, and the Sierra Vista Extension of Sidewalks.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

Ms. Jeanne Shaw, Elfrida Citizens Alliance representative, addressed the Board on alliance projects and her interest to put forward projects for the CDBG grant for three dilapidated mobile homes that need rehabilitation. Chairman English asked Ms. Shaw to put her request in writing and submit it to Ms. Marra.

Chairman English closed the Call to the Public.

Ms. Marra stated that the next step is to have a meeting with the State CDBG Board and present the possible projects then bring back to the Board to select the projects to submit for the grant.

ACTION

Health & Social Services

7. Approve the Letter of Agreement between Cochise Health & Social Services and Health Choice Arizona/Health Choice Generations (AHCCCS and Medicare health plans, respectively), for the initial one year period and to be renewed for subsequent one-year periods.

This item was presented by Mr. Ray Falkenberg, Administrative Services Manager. Mr. Falkenberg stated that partnering with other health plans is of benefit to both the County and its citizens and noted that there would be an opportunity to partner with other health plans in the future.

Supervisor Call moved to Approve the Letter of Agreement between Cochise Health & Social Services and Health Choice Arizona/Health Choice Generations (AHCCCS and Medicare health plans, respectively), for the initial one year period and to be renewed for subsequent one-year periods. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.
