

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, MARCH 26, 2013**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, March 26, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Ann English, Chairman; Richard Searle, Vice-Chairman; Patrick Call, Supervisor; Mike Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Britt Hanson, Chief Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board.

Chairman English called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

ROLL CALL – All three supervisors present.

PRESENTATION

Mr. Ray Falkenberg, Health Administrative Services Manager, explained the program and why the trees were planted. He thanked Freeport McMoran for their environmental interest in the County and said the Facilities Management staff had been crucial to the success of this event.

CONSENT

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of March 12, 2013.
2. Approve the appointments of the following persons as Precinct Committee person for the Republican Party of Cochise County: Precinct # 24 St. David, Leo M. Lesueur; and the following person as Precinct Committee person for the Democrat Party of Cochise County: Precinct #14 Greater San Pedro, Debbie Hickman.

3. Approve the appointment of Mr. Joe Garcia to the Planning and Zoning Commission representing District 2, to fill a vacancy due to the resignation of Mr. Raul Montano, for the remainder of his term ending December 31, 2015.

4. Approve a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that provides for The Nature Conservancy to monitor a Military Conservation Easement annually at no cost to Cochise County.
5. Approve the proposed settlement of the Tax Appeal in Mario and Debbie Saldivar v. Cochise County, ST2012-000829 (Assessor parcel No. 02-408-120-30), now pending in Arizona Tax Court, a division of the Superior Court of and for Maricopa County.
6. Approve the proposed settlement of the Tax Appeal in James R. Thompson and Audrey M. Thompson v. Cochise County, ST2012-000564 (Assessor parcel No. 202-42-017), now pending in Arizona Tax Court, a division of the Superior Court of and for Maricopa County.

7. Approve reappointments of Superior Court Judge Pro Tempore, Donna M. Beumler, pursuant to ARS 12-141; Juvenile Court Commissioners/Judges Pro Tempore Margaret Macartney, and Ann Battaglia-Roberts, pursuant to ARS 8-231 and 12-141; and approve authorization to call upon an appropriately appointed Superior Court Judge Pro Tempore from another county in extenuating circumstances pursuant to ARS 12-144; Justice Court Precinct Five Pro Tempore, Leslie Sansone and county-wide Justices of the Peace Pro Tempore Ann S. Lund, Gerald F. 8. Approve the Agreement with State of Arizona for Broadband Technical Assistance in the amount of \$19,600 with in-kind match of \$4,900 to utilize the consultant services of KAED Consulting and One Random to complete a GAP Analysis for the four Southeastern Counties of Cochise, Graham, Greenlee, and Santa Cruz.

9. Approve the Agreement with State of Arizona for Broadband Planning Assistance in the amount of \$30,000 with in-kind match of \$7,500 to utilize the consultant services of Systems Technology Staffing, LLC to create a broadband development plan for the four Southeastern Counties of Cochise, Graham, Greenlee, and Santa Cruz.

10. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers.

11. Approve the award of Invitation for Bids (IFB) No. 13-28-FMD-04 to Lawley Motors for the purchase of eight 2013 Chevrolet Tahoe Patrol Vehicles for the Fleet Management Department in the amount of \$226,536 plus applicable tax.

Juvenile Probation

12. Adopt Resolution 13-06 electing Cochise County to participate in the Family Counseling Program and authorizing a Grant Match of an additional \$250.

Chairman English removed items 4 and 5 at the request of the Attorney's Office.

Vice-Chairman Searle made a motion to approve items 1-3 and 6-12 of the Consent Agenda. Supervisor Call seconded the motion and it carried unanimously 3-0.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Community Development

13. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 13-02, approving Docket Z-13-01, conditionally amending the zoning district designation for Parcel 102-57-338, from TR-9 to MR-1, pursuant to the application of Ms. Maria Yesca.

Mr. Michael Turisk, Planning Manager, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Turisk discussed the background of the property and the current issues. He stated that the Planning and Zoning Commission had voted for a conditional approval. He clarified that if the Board approved the rezoning the second building would not be within County regulation, but would be in conformance with the Naco Community Plan. He said that after the Board's approval the owner would still have to attend a public hearing with the Board of Adjustments to attain the proper permits.

Vice-Chairman Searle asked if the new building had a bath and what year it had originally been built.

Mr. Turisk said that the property owner could answer these questions.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

Mr. David Rogers, property owner, said the structure was built in 1953 and was a garage until they decided to turn it into a rental property.

Chairman English closed the Call to the Public.

Supervisor Call moved to adopt Zoning Ordinance 13-02, approving Docket Z-13-01, conditionally amending the zoning district designation for Parcel 102-57-338, from TR-9 to MR-1, pursuant to the application of Ms. Maria Yesca. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried unanimously 3-0.

ACTION

Community Development

14. Adopt Resolution 13-07 abandoning portions of 4th Street, Washington Avenue, Jefferson Avenue and alleyways adjoining Bowie School properties, as described therein.

This item was presented by Ms. Karen Riggs, Interim Community Development Director, using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Riggs explained the request to abandon the rights of way was because Bowie school buildings were in the middle of the rights of way and there were no reasons to keep these public rights of way. She stated that the County had made sure that any utility easements were kept and said that staff is recommending approval. She noted that the Bowie school board is also in agreement to abandon these rights of way.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to adopt Resolution 13-07 abandoning portions of 4th Street, Washington Avenue, Jefferson Avenue and alleyways adjoining Bowie School properties, as described therein. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried unanimously 3-0.

15. Uphold or Deny the property owners appeal of the Notice and Order to Abate on parcels 107-19-005C, 107-19-005D, and 107-19-004B.

This item was presented by Mr. Michael Turisk, Planning Manager, using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Turisk said that the appeal was to abate a hazard on the three mentioned parcels in the incorporated Sierra Vista area. He said that although the original cost was estimated at \$800,000, using County resources would lower it and noted that staff recommended denial of the appeal.

Chairman English inquired about the liabilities involved with this issue and the interest in this project.

Mr. Hanson said that the liability would be the same as for other cleanup projects, but noted that the cost of the clean up was more than the value of the property.

Mr. Ortega said that he had asked staff to research issues with property because of several concerns of potential hazards to the area.

Mr. Hanson stated that in order to fence area the owners would have to sign a document giving their permission.

Ms. Linda Yahtzee, property owner, stated that she understood the severity of the situation, but due to her family's financial situation they could not clean the property without help.

Mr. Hanson said that in order to make formal decisions about the cost of cleanup and fencing the Board would have to discuss in a work session or add another agenda item that had more detail.

Vice-Chairman Searle noted that in the past hazardous areas had been fenced off by the County to prevent access.

Supervisor Call moved to deny the property owners appeal of the Notice and Order to Abate on parcels 107-19-005C, 107-19-005D, and 107-19-004B. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried unanimously 3-0.

Chairman English opened the Call to the Public.

Jack Cook addressed the Board on matters of personal concern. No one else chose to speak.

Chairman English closed the Call to the Public.

STATE & FEDERAL LEGISLATION

16. Discussion and possible action regarding state and federal legislative matters, including but not limited to the items in the attached County Supervisors Association Legislative Policy Committee Agenda, the proposed State budget.

Mr. Ortega reported that he had been monitoring the budget situation at the State and that the County Supervisors Association (CSA) also relayed budget information.

Supervisor Call said that he was closely following HB2338 which impact the County's ability to deal with local water issues. He also said the bill regarding road improvement maintenance districts supported by Gail Griffin was a good bill that would positively impact our community.

No action was taken on this agenda item.
