# MOU History



- Initial MOU Outreach began in 2007
- Schools and Churches=38
- Senior Center, Utilities, SEABHS
- Walmart
- Cenpatico
- Sierra Vista Regional Health Center
- Closed POD MOU with Fry's Food Store
- Flower Shop MOU for Mass Fatalities

# Provisions of Closed POD MOU



- **The County PHEP Program Shall:**
  - Emergency Preparedness Point of Contact
  - Environmental Health Sanitation Inspections
  - Assistance with POD Logistics
  - Provide Medications/Vaccinations
  - Adhere to Federal and State Mandated Directives during an Emergency Event
- **Fry's Shall:**
  - Store Manager Point of Contact
  - Store Facility Space and POD set up
  - Provide Parking and Pharmacy Staff
  - Provide Ability to Dispense to Staff and Families

# Benefit to County



- Allows Fry's to administer Vaccinations or Medications to a segment of the Population without Public Health Assistance
- Removes that number of Citizens from Open POD Response
- Ensures the Fry's Food Store remains open during a Disaster
- Free up the Public Health Nurses to Staff Open POD's
- Exemplifies Community Preparedness

# Summary:



- Maricopa, Yavapai, and Pinal have signed Closed POD Agreements with Fry's Food Store
- The Arizona Department of Health Services has endorsed the Fry's MOU and encourages Closed POD MOU's
- The PHEP Program will continue to pursue Closed POD MOU's within the County to reduce the number of Citizens relying on Mass Dispensing
