

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, APRIL 23, 2013**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, April 9, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Ann English, Chairman; Richard Searle, Vice-Chairman; Patrick Call, Supervisor; Mike Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Dave Fifer, Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board.

Chairman English called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

ROLL CALL – All three supervisors present.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Chairman English opened the Call to the Public.

Dale Powers addressed the Board about dust problems in the Bowie area due to neighbors and stated that he felt the County should be involved since several people are having health issues.

Jack Cook addressed the Board on matters of personal concern.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman English closed the Call to the Public.

CONSENT

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of April 9, 2013.
2. Approve the appointments of the following persons as Precinct Committee person for the Democrat Party of Cochise County: Precinct # 04 BI Bisbee, Mary Elizabeth Thornton; Precinct #42, SV Vista Village, David H. Beeksma.

Finance

3. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers.

Health

4. Approve the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program Education (SNAP ED), Subcontract renewal between the University of Arizona Board of Regents and Cochise Health and Social Services, in the amount of \$32,990.64, for the period of 10/1/2012 to 9/30/2013.

Supervisor Call made a motion to approve items 1-4 of the Consent Agenda. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion and it carried unanimously 3-0.

ACTION

Community Development

5. Approve an Assurance Agreement Extension for the Linda Vista Subdivision to March 22, 2017, at the request of the Developer, Mr. Edward O. Garcia.

Mr. Keith Dennis, Planner II, presented this item using a PowerPoint Presentation. Mr. Dennis gave the background of the subdivision and explained that the applicant was asking for an extension now because of economic impact on the applicant's financial ability to complete phase 4 even though the expiration date was not until next year. Mr. Dennis said that staff recommends approval.

Mr. Edward Garcia, applicant, stated that the request was so that gas lines and electrical lines could be completed during phase 4. He said that he would try to complete the subdivision as fast as he could, but noted that the economy had been a major impact on his moving forward.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to approve an Assurance Agreement Extension for the Linda Vista Subdivision to March 22, 2017, at the request of the Developer, Mr. Edward O. Garcia. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Supervisor Call said that this was a good subdivision and he was happy that it was moving forward.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried unanimously 3-0.

Facilities

6. Approve Cooperative Agreement # L13AC00052 with the Bureau of Land Management to develop a Countywide Community Wildfire Protection Plan, accept funding in the amount of \$20,000, secure funding from the AZ Forestry Division in the amount of \$14,500, and provide additional funding of \$34,103 to complete the first phase of the Plan.

This item was presented by Ms. Lisa Marra, Grants Administrator. Ms. Marra stated that the purpose was to support us in the effort to finalize a plan. She said that development of the plan was started in 2007 and that all 16 fire districts were included in developing the plan. She confirmed that forming a partnership with the Bureau of Land Management would help finalize the plan and positively impact our communities. She reviewed the details of the agreement and noted that the major portion that the County funding is for a consultant to come in and finish the protection plan. Ms. Marra clarified that although some areas in the County already had a plan this plan would bring everyone together under the same plan and help unify all the fire districts.

Supervisor Call moved to approve Cooperative Agreement # L13AC00052 with the Bureau of Land Management to develop a Countywide Community Wildfire Protection Plan, accept funding in the amount of \$20,000, secure funding from the AZ Forestry Division in the amount of \$14,500, and provide additional funding of \$34,103 to complete the first phase of the Plan. Chairman English seconded the motion.

Vice-Chairman Searle asked if instead of using a consultant we could use in-house employees.

Ms. Marra said that it was up to the Board to decide who would use the funds to complete the plan, but she supported hiring a consultant.

Mr. Ortega said that he did not have the resources in house to complete this plan, but would discuss with staff and get back to the Board.

Chairman English noted that approving this agreement does not mean that we have to act on it immediately, but just guarantees that we secure the funds so that we can complete the plan in the future.

Ms. Marra stated that the main benefit of having a completed plan would be coordinating and sharing of resources countywide.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was approved 2-1 (Searle opposed).

Chairman English asked staff to keep the Board informed of the process of this agreement.

Health

7. Approve the Intergovernmental Agreement between Cochise County and the City of Douglas for the Exchange of Services and Facilities for the period of March 26, 2013 through December 31, 2014, for the purpose of providing exercise and health coach services for the City of Douglas and County employees.

Ms. Judy Gilligan, Prevention Services Director, presented this item. Ms. Gilligan explained that the reason for the agreement was to provide more opportunities for County employees to get fit, while also allowing the City of Douglas employees to participate in our Active Adults program.

The Board stated that they were happy to see partnerships like this one form to benefit our employees.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement between Cochise County and the City of Douglas for the Exchange of Services and Facilities for the period of March 26, 2013 through December 31, 2014, for the purpose of providing exercise and health coach services for the City of Douglas and County employees.

Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried unanimously 3-0.

8. Approve a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Fry's Food Store in Sierra Vista and Cochise County for the purpose of providing mass distribution of vaccinations or medications in the event of a disaster or emergency to Fry's employees and their families, utilizing a closed point of dispensing method effective for a 5-year term, with automatic 5-year renewals.

This item was presented by Ms. Elizabeth Lueck, Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Director, using a PowerPoint Presentation. Ms. Lueck said that many counties statewide participate in memorandums such as this one to help distribute vaccines during emergency situations. She stated that Fry's employees would not receive preferential treatment; that all guidance provided by the Center for Disease and Control (CDC) would be followed; and that staff recommends approval.

Supervisor Call asked why closed point of dispensing MOUs is beneficial.

Ms. Lueck stated that it reduces the amount of people that the County has to treat and helps with the distribution of immunizations countywide.

Supervisor Call moved to approve a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Fry's Food Store in Sierra Vista and Cochise County for the purpose of providing mass distribution of vaccinations or medications in the event of a disaster or emergency to Fry's employees and their families, utilizing a closed point of dispensing method effective for a 5-year term, with automatic 5-year renewals. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried unanimously 3-0.

7. Approve the Ancillary Services Agreement between Cochise Health & Social Services and Cigna Healthcare of Arizona, Inc., effective for a one-year term, with automatic annual renewals.

Mr. Ray Falkenberg, Administrative Services Manager, presented this item. Mr. Falkenberg said that it fits with our plan of expanding our network with private companies in order to provide services to our citizens and staff recommends approval.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to approve the Ancillary Services Agreement between Cochise Health & Social Services and Cigna Healthcare of Arizona, Inc., effective for a one-year term, with automatic annual renewals. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried unanimously 3-0.
