

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, JUNE 11, 2013**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, June 11, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Ann English, Chairman; Richard Searle, Vice-Chairman; Patrick Call, Supervisor; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Dave Fifer, Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board.

Chairman English called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Chairman English noted that the consent agenda would be first, followed by the action agenda (items 10-14), public hearings (items 8-9), and ending with the call to the public.

ROLL CALL – All three supervisors present.

CONSENT

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of May 21, 2013.
2. Approve an application for a Permanent Extension of Premises liquor license submitted by Mr. John L. Permenter for P-C Cattlerest Bar located on 933 S. Haskell Road in Willcox.

County Treasurer

3. Approve the renewal of Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 10-46-TRE-03 for Banking Services with JP Morgan Chase Bank for the County Treasurer for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2015.

County Sheriff

4. Approve Contract #2013-164-050 between the Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) and the Sheriff's Office providing \$46,000 in funding for a DUI Enforcement vehicle for the term of October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2013.

Finance

5. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers.

Warrants Nos. 69903-69906, 69908-70003, 70024-70036, 70041-70172, and 70174-70383 were issued in the amount of \$1,452,482.99.

Health

6. Approve ADHS IGA#13-036322, STD Services, between the Arizona Department of Health Services and Cochise Health & Social Services, in the amount of \$2,271 for the period of 1/1/13 – 12/31/13.

Indigent Defense

7. Approve the renewal of contracts for Indigent Defense Contract Services to seventeen Attorneys for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014.

Vice-Chairman Searle made a motion to approve items 1-7 of the Consent Agenda. Supervisor Call seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARING

Board of Supervisors

8. Adopt Resolution 13-13 granting the combination of existing franchises East Slope Water Company, Antelope Run Water Company, and Indiada Water into one franchise namely East Slope Water Company, Inc. for a 25 year term effective June 11, 2013 to June 11, 2038.

Dave Fifer, Civil Deputy Attorney, presented this item. Mr. Fifer stated that the sole purpose of this franchise was to combine three different franchises into one under the East Slope Water Company name.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

Ms. Patricia Gerrodette, a Sierra Vista resident, said that she was very supportive of the merging of the three companies, but was confused by the wording used in the public notice.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Chairman English said that the item seemed very clear in the purpose it was trying to achieve.

Mr. Fifer clarified that the Board reserved the right to pose further restrictions if the company tried to change the details of the franchise.

Supervisor Call moved to adopt Resolution 13-13 granting the combination of existing franchises East Slope Water Company, Antelope Run Water Company, and Indiada Water into one franchise namely East Slope Water Company, Inc. for a 25 year term effective June 11, 2013 to June 11, 2038. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English stated that the purpose of this resolution was to combine the three companies and not change any other details.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Community Development

9. Approve Docket SUA-13-04A, Audubon Arizona, an appeal of Planning and Zoning Commission's April 10, 2013, approval of Docket SU-13-04, Red Horse Wind 2, Torch Renewable Energy Advisors, LLC special use permit.

Ms. Beverly Wilson, Deputy Director of Planning, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Wilson reviewed the details of the project: nature of appeal, concept design, conditions placed on docket by the planning and zoning commission, and the public response. She said that the applicant was currently going through the right-of-way process and noted that other agencies have had the opportunity to submit any input. She stated that there had been letters received in support and opposition from citizens and other government agencies and noted that the Arizona Game and Fish Department had submitted an email stating that the applicant has agreed to their standards. Ms. Wilson said that staff recommended that the Board uphold the planning and zoning commission's decision.

Chairman English clarified that approval of the appeal meant denying the planning and zoning's recommendation.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

These individuals spoke in favor of appeal:

Margaret Case, Palominas resident; Vashti "Tice" Supplee, Audubon Arizona representative; Patricia Gerrodette, Sierra Vista resident; Homer Hansen, Willcox resident.

These individuals spoke against appeal:

George Scott, Southeast Arizona Economic Development representative; Nancy-Jean Welker, President of the Bowie Chamber of Commerce.

Mr. Jonathan Kilberg, Torch Renewable Energy President (applicant), stated that there were both economic and environmental benefits to the project and clarified that his company was in compliance with Federal and State regulations.

Mr. Tom Koronkiewics, SWCA Environmental Consultants (avian ecologist hired by Torch company), stated that the avian research done had been very extensive and that this company does their due diligence to ensure that they comply with all regulations.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Mr. Searle presented proposed language that would ensure the applicant was in compliance with environmental regulations.

Mr. Fifer advised the Board that they had three options: uphold the appeal, deny the appeal, or modify the original project to add desired language. He also said that the Board would have to give reason on why a modification was made.

Mr. Kilberg stated that although the proposed language was duplicative his company did not have an issue with adding it to the original project proposal.

Chairman English stated that the reason the Board opted to deny the appeal and modify the original proposal was because they did not feel the need to duplicate every regulation that the company had already complied with.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to deny Docket SUA-13-04A, Audubon Arizona, an appeal of Planning and Zoning Commission's April 10, 2013, approval of Docket SU-13-04, Red Horse Wind 2, Torch Renewable Energy Advisors, LLC special use permit and include modification to the original proposal to include the following language:

- Applicant shall submit the Preliminary Screening and Pre-Construction Study Plan to Arizona Game, Fish, and Wildlife Department (AZGFD) with a copy sent to Cochise County
- Applicant shall continue its environmental monitoring program and studies; applicant will submit findings to AZGFD and provide a copy to Cochise County
- Applicant shall use commercially reasonable efforts to reduce any potential negative impacts to avian species (specifically eagles) and bat species
- Applicant shall develop an invasive weed control plan, which will be provided to AZGFD and Cochise County
- Applicant shall install no more lighting than what is required by the Federal Aviation Administration
- \$3 million for roads can be cash or bond

Vice-Chairman Searle stated that the \$3 million bonding requirement was more economically feasible for the company and still protected County roads. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

ACTION

Board of Supervisors

10. Approve an award of contract for Legal Advertising Services in accordance with ARS §11-255, and as per responses received to Invitation for Bids (IFB) No. 13-38-PUR-03 to _____ at a cost of \$_____ per column inch for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014.

Mr. Dave Seward, Procurement Director, presented this item. Mr. Seward stated that this is an annual contract for County's advertising services. He said there were only two bids submitted and that staff recommended the Arizona Range News because of the lower price, \$1.25 per column inch compared to the Sierra Vista Heralds' \$2.50.

Supervisor Call moved to approve an award of contract for Legal Advertising Services in accordance with ARS §11-255, and as per responses received to Invitation for Bids (IFB) No. 13-38-PUR-03 to the Arizona Range News at a cost of \$1.25 per column inch for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Community Development

11. Adopt Resolution 13-14, to abandon a portion of Ghost Town Trail right-of-way adjoining the Pearce Jail and to convey the Pearce Jail, including the abandoned right-of-way, to Old Pearce Preservation Association, as described therein.

Mr. Terry Couchenour, Right-of-Way Agent, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Couchenour went over the background of the jail and stated that the Board would have to take two actions; one to abandon the right-of-way, and the other to deed the jail to the Old Pearce Preservation Association. He showed pictures of the location and explained that an auction was not required because the jail was going to a non-profit organization.

Vice-Chairman Searle commended staff on their work on this project.

Chairman English noted that projects like this one went along with the County's mission of preserving historical sites.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to Adopt Resolution 13-14, to abandon a portion of Ghost Town Trail right-of-way adjoining the Pearce Jail and to convey the Pearce Jail, including the abandoned right-of-way, to Old Pearce Preservation Association, as described therein. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

County Assessor

12. Board of Supervisors sitting as the Board of Equalization for Cochise County will uphold or amend the Assessor's decision for the Petition for Review of Taxpayer Notice of Claim for parcel 202-01-009 E (Madison Diversified 882 Corp).

Chairman English noted that the Board of Supervisors is sitting as the Board of Equalization to hear this item.

Mr. Phil Leiendecker, County Assessor, presented this item. Mr. Leiendecker gave a brief description of the background and stated that the parcel in question was a large parcel and that the property owner had requested agricultural status for 2009, 2010, 2011, and 2013 stating that the Assessor's Office had made an error. He said that his office had reviewed the request and denied it based on the time limitation for the error statute. He stated that staff recommended the decision be upheld since the claim did not meet the requirements for an appeal.

The applicant was notified, but did not attend.

Supervisor Call moved to uphold the Assessor's decision for the Petition for Review of Taxpayer Notice of Claim for parcel 202-01-009 E (Madison Diversified 882 Corp) Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

County Sheriff

13. Approve City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Grant Agreement HT-13-2330 with a term of January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2014 providing a total of \$109,659 in salary, employee related expenses, overtime, vehicle expenses and equipment to assign one deputy sheriff to the Southeastern Arizona Major Investigative Team (SAMIT), a U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration drug enforcement task force.

Lieutenant Rich Morales, Sheriff's Office, presented this item. Lt. Morales went over the background and listed what the grant monies would cover. He noted that there was not a County match for this grant.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to approve City of Tucson High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Grant Agreement HT-13-2330 with a term of January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2014 providing a total of \$109,659 in salary, employee related expenses, overtime, vehicle expenses and equipment to assign one deputy sheriff to the Southeastern Arizona Major Investigative Team (SAMIT), a U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration drug enforcement task force. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Health

14. Approve the Ancillary Services Agreement between Cochise Health & Social Services and Aetna Health, Inc. effective for a one-year term beginning on June 15, 2013 with automatic annual renewals.

Mr. Ray Falkenberg, Administrative Services Manager, presented this item. Mr. Falkenberg said that this agreement was for the expansion of the insurance network and similar to other contracts recently approved by the Board.

Supervisor Call moved to approve the Ancillary Services Agreement between Cochise Health & Social Services and Aetna Health, Inc. effective for a one-year term beginning on June 15, 2013 with automatic annual renewals. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

STATE & FEDERAL LEGISLATION

15. Discussion and possible action regarding state and federal legislative matters, including but not limited to the items in the attached County Supervisors Association Legislative Policy Committee Agenda, the proposed State budget.

Chairman English noted that the State was still working on the budget.

No action was taken on this agenda item.

Chairman English opened the Call to the Public.

Mr. Mike Jackson addressed the Board regarding the County's building code agenda item on the upcoming Planning & Zoning Commission meeting.
