

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, JUNE 25, 2013**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, June 25, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Ann English, Chairman; Richard Searle, Vice-Chairman; Patrick Call, Supervisor; Michael Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator; Adam Ambrose, Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Arlethe Rios, Assistant to the Clerk of the Board.

Chairman English called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

CONSENT

Board of Supervisors

1. Appoint Mr. Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator, as interim Clerk of the Board effective as of June 25, 2013.
2. Approve an agreement for conditional gift with the Warne Family Foundation for a bronze sculpture, to be displayed in the Board of Supervisors' Office lobby, depicting the miner George Warren, whose likeness appears on the Great Seal of the State of Arizona and which honors the role that mining played in the development and continuing progress of Arizona.
3. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of June 11, 2013.

Health

13. Approve Amendment #6 to IGA #YH07-0007-04 between Cochise County and AHCCCS for detention inmate inpatient medical care, extending the contract for the period of 1/1/13 – 12/1/14.

Indigent Defense

14. Approve the award of Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 13-06-IDC-01 to Nancy Bourke, ESQ., to provide Indigent Defense Services for class 6 through 2 felony cases and delinquency cases.

Juvenile Probation

15. Adopt Resolution 13-19 to approve fiscal year 2013-14 Family Counseling Funding as provided by the Arizona Supreme Court, Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC), Juvenile Justice Services Division (JJSD), and the required \$4,033 matching funds as budgeted in the general fund budget submitted by Juvenile Court Services.

Workforce Development

16. Approve Title IB Adult, Youth, and Dislocated Worker PY13/FY14 contract between Cochise County and the Arizona Department of Economic Security for the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Service Delivery Area from April 1, 2013 to June 30, 2015.

17. Approve Amendment #11 to Title IB Adult, Youth, and Dislocated Worker contract DE111004001 between Cochise County and the Arizona Department of Economic Security for the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Service Delivery Area from April 1, 2010 to August 31, 2015.

Vice-Chairman Searle made a motion to approve items 1-17 of the Consent Agenda. Supervisor Call seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mr. Ortega noted that the date for the presentation for the bronze figured mentioned in item 2 has not been set, but he would keep the Board updated on the status.

PUBLIC HEARING

Community Development

18. Adopt Ordinance 045-13 approving the establishment of a Building Code Advisory and Appeals Board, Docket R-13-05 with the by-laws attached.

Ms. Beverly Wilson, Community Development Deputy Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Wilson discussed the background, specifically the authority for the Board to create the two boards. She said that

there were alternatives to creating two separate boards and noted that the building code could also be amended to address any concerns from staff and the public.

Supervisor Call asked how the planning and zoning commission voted on this topic.

Ms. Wilson said that they it was a 6-2 vote.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

Ms. Helene Jackson, McNeal resident, addressed the Board on her concerns of combining the two boards citing conflict of interest.

Mr. William Jacobek, St. David resident, addressed the Board on how either board could impact the County's building code.

Chairman English entered into record an email from Ms. Jere Fredenburgh, Sierra Vista resident, and her concerns on combining the two boards.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman Searle said he asked for an alternative to be added after discussing the issue with the commissioners from district 3, who did not have clear view on this. He stated that having an alternative would address the issues of all those concerned.

Chairman English said she supported staff recommendation and felt that two separate boards were not necessary as the Board of Supervisors should have the last say on appeals.

Supervisor Call stated that he appreciated the public's input, but also felt that a combined board would serve this purpose.

Ms. Wilson clarified the process of an appeal would come from the building official, not the advisory board. She said that the advisory board would advise the building official and the Board of Supervisors on amending the building code.

Mr. Ambrose stated that citizens would still have an opportunity to appeal to the Board if they did not agree with the appeals board.

Supervisor Call moved to adopt Ordinance 045-13 approving the establishment of a Building Code Advisory and Appeals Board, Docket R-13-05 with the by-laws attached. Chairman English seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 2-0-1 (Searle opposed).

19. Adopt Resolution 13-18 authorizing qualified professional services registrants to self-certify compliance with county building and related codes with an applicant's approval, thereby establishing a Registrant Self-Certification Policy, Docket R-13-06, resulting in a waiver of plan review fees.

Ms. Beverly Wilson, Deputy Director of Planning, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Wilson stated that it is a policy change, which makes it possible for professional services registrants to voluntarily self certify. She said that this would save plan review fees for applicants and noted that the planning and zoning commission had voted 8-0 to approve this resolution.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

Mr. Mike Jackson, McNeal resident, addressed the Board on his personal concerns regarding fees in planning and zoning.

Jack Cook addressed the Board on matters of personal concern.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to adopt Resolution 13-18 authorizing qualified professional services registrants to self-certify compliance with county building and related codes with an applicant's approval, thereby establishing a

Registrant Self-Certification Policy, Docket R-13-06, resulting in a waiver of plan review fees. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Health

20. Adopt Resolution 13-15 to establish a new fee schedule for Tuberculosis (TB) Testing Services provided by Cochise Health & Social Services for testing, education, screening and treatment of clients with cases of tuberculosis, effective on and after July 26, 2013.

Ms. Radi Ann Porter, Director of Nursing, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Porter said that the request to increase TB skin testing fees, a mandated program, was due to flat funding from the State not covering County cost. She stated that there had not been an increase in fees in over 15 years and that costs were impacting staff's ability to provide services. She noted that the fee would be increasing from \$15 to \$25 and that nurses had the ability to waive fees if someone who needed to get tested could not afford the fee.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Supervisor Call moved to adopt Resolution 13-15 to establish a new fee schedule for Tuberculosis (TB) Testing Services provided by Cochise Health & Social Services for testing, education, screening and treatment of clients with cases of tuberculosis, effective on and after July 26, 2013. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

ACTION

Community Development

21. Approve Extension of Assurance Agreement for the completion of the Rancho Arizona Subdivision improvements, Docket S-03-02, to July 6, 2016, per the request of developers James W. Sandlin and Terry L. Russell.

Mr. Keith Dennis, Planner II, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Dennis said that the subdivision had been started in 2006, had 4 parcels, and was located in the Pearce area. He stated that the request was due to the economy and noted that staff recommended approval.

Vice-Chairman Searle asked if this was the first or second extension.

Mr. Dennis said this would actually be the third extension, but clarified that the first extension was an administrative extension.

Mr. Jim Salmon, subdivision owner, explained that he had not made any improvements as of yet due to the economy. He said that any improvements done would be outdated and not maintained and he did not want the improvements to deteriorate.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to approve Extension of Assurance Agreement for the completion of the Rancho Arizona Subdivision improvements, Docket S-03-02, to July 6, 2016, per the request of developers James W. Sandlin and Terry L. Russell. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

22. Approve Resolution 13-16 authorizing the abandonment of the Winwood Addition to Bisbee Subdivision, per the request of owner Freeport McMoran, Incorporated.

Mr. Keith Dennis, Planner II, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Dennis said that this was a complete abandonment and that staff recommended approval.

Supervisor Call moved to approve Resolution 13-16 authorizing the abandonment of the Winwood Addition to Bisbee Subdivision, per the request of owner Freeport McMoran, Incorporated. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

23. Approve Right-of-Way Encroachment License Agreement with Kings Ranch at Coronado Home Owners Association, Inc. as described herein.

Ms. Karen Riggs, Community Development Interim Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Riggs showed a map of the location, went over the background noting that the agreement was to have Kings Ranch take care of the landscaping the rights of way and removing the County from that responsibility, and said that staff recommended approval.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to approve Right-of-Way Encroachment License Agreement with Kings Ranch at Coronado Home Owners Association, Inc. as described herein. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

County Sheriff

24. Approve the award of Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 13-32-SHF-03 to Keefe Commissary Network for Inmate Commissary Services for the Sheriff's Office for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014.

Mr. Dave Seward, Procurement Director, presented this item. Mr. Seward said that the contract will expire soon and needs to be reapproved. He stated that four proposals had been received and Keefe was still the lowest price.

Supervisor Call moved to approve the award of Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 13-32-SHF-03 to Keefe Commissary Network for Inmate Commissary Services for the Sheriff's Office for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

Facilities

25. Adopt Resolution 13-17 authorizing application for a Cooperative Watershed Management Grant from the Federal Bureau of Reclamation in the amount of \$50,000 with no match required.

Ms. Lisa Marra, Grants Administrator, presented this item. Ms. Marra said that a local match was not required and that the grant would be used to complete the plan and set up a group to manage the plan. She stated that there were three different watersheds within the County and that letters of support had been received from Fort Huachuca, Upper San Pedro Partnership, Cochise Water Project, and the Coronado Resource Conservation and Development Area.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to adopt Resolution 13-17 authorizing application for a Cooperative Watershed Management Grant from the Federal Bureau of Reclamation in the amount of \$50,000 with no match required. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

STATE & FEDERAL LEGISLATION

26. Discussion and possible action regarding state and federal legislative matters, including but not limited to the items in the attached County Supervisors Association Legislative Policy Committee Agenda, the proposed State budget.

Mr. Ortega stated that there would be no additional costs to the County this year and that staff had been successful in keeping the same level of funding.

No action was taken on this agenda item.

Chairman English opened the Call to the Public.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the Call to the Public.
