

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
REGARDING
BORDER CRIMES UNIT**

AMENDMENT 01

WHEREAS, the Cochise County Board of Supervisors and the U.S. Border Patrol, (hereinafter referred to as "Agency") entered into an IGA on July 15, 2013; and

WHEREAS, this IGA represents a collaborative effort of the Cochise County Sheriff's Office and the Agency to enhance law enforcement services as pertains to crimes occurring with Cochise County; and

WHEREAS, this collaborative effort is beneficial to the wellbeing of those who are located in Cochise County; and

WHEREAS, the parties to this Agreement wish to maintain the terms and conditions of this IGA in all regards excepting one sentence contained in section **1. Participation**; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to delete in its entirety the second sentence contained in section **1. Participation**, which reads as follows "*Said agents shall be deputized with 'peace officer' status by the Cochise County Sheriff, pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-441 and A.R.S. § 13-3875,*"

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED that the IGA is amended to reflect the deletion of the above italicized sentence with all other terms and conditions to remain the same.




