

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD ON
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2013**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, November 5, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona. In attendance were Ann English, Chairman; Richard Searle, Vice-Chairman; Patrick Call, Supervisor; Mike Ortega, County Administrator; Jim Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator, Britt Hanson, Chief Civil Deputy County Attorney; and Arlethe Rios, Clerk of the Board.

Chairman English called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIENCE

ROLL CALL – All three supervisors present.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Chairman English opened the Call to the Public.

Mr. Robert Gent, Sierra Vista resident, addressed the Board on his concerns with lighting code violations in the County.

Mr. Craig Langham, Sierra Vista resident, addressed the Board on his lighting code concerns in the Hereford area.

Mr. Jack Cook addressed the Board on matters of personal concern.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman English closed the Call to the Public.

PRESENTATION

A presentation by Carrie Gustavson, Director of the Bisbee Mining & Historical Museum, regarding upcoming events of the Bisbee Business & Professional Women's (BBPW) Club.

Ms. Gustavson, BBPW club representative, said that the club would be honoring Chairman English as the Woman of achievement for 2013 on November 20 at Café Roka. She stated that the club members truly appreciated Chairman English's work in the community.

CONSENT

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the Agreement with the State of Arizona for Broadband Planning Assistance in the amount of \$32,500 with in-kind match of \$8,125 to utilize the consultant services of Systems Technology Staffing, LLC to create Phase II of a broadband development plan for the four Southeastern Counties of Cochise, Graham, Greenlee, and Santa Cruz.
2. Approve the Agreement with the State of Arizona for Broadband Technical Assistance in the amount of \$22,725 with in-kind match of \$5,681.25 to utilize the consultant services of One Random Act, LLC to complete Phase II of a GAP Analysis for the four Southeastern Counties of Cochise, Graham, Greenlee, and Santa Cruz.
3. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of October 22, 2013
4. Approve the appointments of the following persons as Precinct Committee person for the Republican Party of Cochise County: Precinct #15 Hereford, Michele Emerson-Roberts; Precinct #40 SV Town & Country, Patrick A. Jones.

5. Approve the Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) Grant #2014-AL-001 between GOHS and the Sheriff's Office to provide \$40,000 for overtime to support and enhance Impaired Driver/DUI Enforcement throughout Cochise County with a term of October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014

Finance

6. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers.

Warrants Nos.74000-74178, 74199-74374 were issued in the amount of \$1,193,940.48.

Pursuant to A.R.S. §11-217(C), the published minutes shall include all demands and warrants approved by the Board in excess of one thousand dollars except that multiple demands and warrants from a single supplier or individual under one thousand dollars whose cumulative total exceeds one thousand dollars in a single reporting period shall also be published.

Issued warrants are listed as an attachment at the end of the minutes.

Supervisor Call made a motion to approve items 1-6 of the Consent Agenda. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARING

Community Development

7. Approve Docket SUA-13-14 (West Edge Appeal), an appeal of a September 11, 2013 Planning Commission decision that granted a Special Use request to establish a Medical Marijuana Cultivation and Infusion operation for parcel 201-20-001B located at 5900 W. Greenhouse Road in Willcox, AZ.

Mr. Keith Dennis, Planner II, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Dennis gave the background of the special use permit and said that the appeal was made after the Planning and Zoning Commission approved the special use permit. He explained that this was a special use permit for a medical marijuana dispensary in Willcox and gave details about the location, concept plan, and operations. He said that neighbors in the area were not opposed to the dispensary and went over the factors in favor of denying the appeal.

Vice-Chairman Searle asked if approving the dispensary would cause more traffic.

Mr. Dennis said that he did not think that more traffic would be caused by the new dispensary.

Mr. John Curran Jr., appellant, said that his major concern with the dispensary was the amount of marijuana that would be grown at the facility and improper security.

Mr. Randy Smith, attorney for the applicant, said that the applicant wanted to provide a low cost, high quality product to the people statewide. He noted that Mr. Curran is a representative for Mr. Brothers, the original appellant at the Planning and Zoning Commission meeting. He stated that the applicant would not be opposed to complying with any regulations set by the Board. Mr. Smith also said that under the State of Arizona there are no limits on production because it is driven by market needs.

Chairman English said that the issue before the Board was to ensure that the zoning was appropriate for the area and operation and noted that the State would ensure all other laws and regulations were met.

Mr. Dennis noted that medical marijuana dispensaries had not been put into a category and was made special use in order for the Board to approve on a case-by-case basis.

Vice-Chairman Searle asked what the next step would be if the special use permit was approved.

Mr. Dennis said that the applicant would then go to the State level to get approved and if he did it would come back to the County for a building permit at which time they would also have to be in compliance with the light pollution code.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

Mr. Ralph Thompson, Willcox resident, said he was in favor of the special use permit.

Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Mr. Hanson clarified that a motion denying the appeal would approve the special use permit.

Vice-Chairman Searle made a motion to approve Docket SUA-13-14 (West Edge Appeal), an appeal of a September 11, 2013 Planning Commission decision that granted a Special Use request to establish a Medical Marijuana Cultivation and Infusion operation for parcel 201-20-001B located at 5900 W. Greenhouse Road in Willcox, AZ. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Vice-Chairman Searle commented on the applicant and stated that there have never been any complaints from neighbors or employees and that the company was a good economic driver.

Supervisor Call said that there were few facts from the appellant and that he agreed with staff that this was a land use issue.

Chairman English agreed that this issue was land use related and said that the Board would follow state requirements for future decisions.

Vice-Chairman Searle clarified that at this time no upgrades had to be made by the applicant to acquire the special use permit.

Chairman English called for the vote and it was denied 0-3.

Items 8 and 9 were heard before item 7.

Health & Social Services

8. Adopt Resolution 13-35 to rescind Resolution 12-29 and to amend the Environmental Health Fees as set forth in Exhibit A, to be effective on and after January 1, 2014.

Mr. Danny Nikitas, Environmental Health Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Nikitas said that both items 8 and 9 would be discussed since they were related. He stated that the permit process had been revised by staff in order to avoid confusion for both employees and citizens. He noted that there would now be 8 permits instead of 24 permits in order to combine several permits that most establishments need to operate. He also said that all nonprofit organizations would be exempt from permit fees.

Supervisor Call said he appreciated the work staff was doing and asked if organizations that were charitable, but not labeled 501c3 would also be exempt.

Mr. Nikitas said that he was not aware of these types of nonprofits, but would add them to the exempt list.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Supervisor Call made a motion to adopt Resolution 13-35 to rescind Resolution 12-29 and to amend the Environmental Health Fees as set forth in Exhibit A, to be effective on and after January 1, 2014. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

9. Adopt Resolution 13-36 to amend the Cochise County Sanitary Code as set forth in Exhibit A, thereby repealing Resolution 12-28, to be effective on and after January 1, 2014.

Mr. Danny Nikitas, Environmental Health Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Nikitas covered this item with item 8.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman Searle made a motion to adopt Resolution 13-36 to amend the Cochise County Sanitary Code as set forth in Exhibit A, thereby repealing Resolution 12-28, to be effective on and after January 1, 2014. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

REPORT BY MICHAEL J. ORTEGA, COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR -- RECENT AND PENDING COUNTY MATTERS

Mr. Ortega said that all County offices would have adequate coverage during the holiday season and noted that they would only be closed on federal holidays.
