

RESOLUTION FCD 13-01

AMENDING THE COCHISE COUNTY FLOODPLAIN REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona delegated responsibility to local governments to adopt floodplain regulations pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 48-3601 through 48-3628; and

WHEREAS, the Cochise County Flood Control District Board first adopted the Floodplain Regulations on July 30, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Floodplain Regulations were amended May 26, 1987, November 6, 2000 and April 9, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Cochise County Flood Control Board has determined that it is necessary to further amend those regulations to comply with current law and to improve clarity; and

WHEREAS, the revised regulations are shown in Attachment A; and

WHEREAS, a properly noticed public hearing was held on January 29, 2013, at which changes to these regulations were considered and found to be in the best interests of the District,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Cochise County Flood Control Regulations, as shown in Attachment A, are hereby adopted and shall become effective thirty (30) days after their adoption, and all existing regulations, or portions thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with these regulations shall be deemed to be repealed.


