

RESOLUTION 14-__

**AUTHORIZING THE ALTERATION OF THE ESTABLISHED
COUNTY HIGHWAY AND AUTHORIZING THE
ACQUISITION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR PORTIONS OF
DAVIS ROAD**

WHEREAS, pursuant to ARS § 28-6701, the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County, Arizona, may alter a highway in the county and acquire real property for this purpose by purchase, donation, dedication, condemnation or other lawful means; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ARS § 28-6701, there has been presented to the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County, Arizona, a recommendation by the County Engineer of said County, praying for the alteration of a County Highway known as Davis Road:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Alter the established width of Davis Road, from 66 feet to 200 feet, approximately beginning at milepost 9.6, and running southeasterly to milepost 10.3, as specified per plans identified as Federal Aid Project Number HPP CCH-0(202) on file in the office of the Cochise County Engineer. Said altered alignment is commonly referred to as improvements to milepost 9.9 and located within Sections 3, 4, 9 and 10, Township 21 South, Range 24 East of the Gila and Salt River Meridian, Cochise County, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors on April 8, 2014, at the hour of 10:00 a.m., held a public hearing on said recommendation, and notice having been given by publication thereof once a week for two (2) weeks in the Arizona Range News, the designated official newspaper for Cochise County notices, and said notice having directed all persons wishing to object to the action prayed for in the petition to file with Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, a statement in writing setting forth any objections or opposition and to show cause why said petition should not be granted; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing the Board of Supervisors considered the feasibility, advantages and necessity of the highway and determined that the alteration of said highway as recommended by the County Engineer is a public necessity; and

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WHEREAS, it having been determined that it is in the best interest of the County and the public at large to acquire said public rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the parcels to be affected by the acquisition of rights-of-way are identified as:

Assessor Parcel Number 111-27-001, Ruth Evelyn Cowan Separate Property Trust

Arizona State Trust Land, Sections 3 & 4, Township 21 South, Range 24 East,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the alteration of the County Highway as above described is hereby approved.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is authorized and directed to file in the office of the County Recorder of Cochise County, Arizona, a certified copy of this resolution and order, together with a map of said highway.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that any previous declaration in conflict herewith is hereby rescinded to the extent of such conflict.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Community Development Department Highway and Floodplain Division, or her designee, is authorized to negotiate on behalf of the County to acquire said public rights-of-way, and settle resulting damages through donation, purchase, or condemnation action as necessary.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that should a condemnation action become necessary to acquire all, or any portion of, said rights-of-way, the Cochise County Attorney's Office is authorized to proceed with said action.

IT IS FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, or the Vice-Chairman, is authorized to accept conveyance documents for said rights-of-way.

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


