

RESOLUTION 10-__

A RESOLUTION OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS CANCELLING THE COCHISE TECHNOLOGY DISTRICT #01 BOARD ELECTION AND APPOINTING FIVE CANDIDATES THAT FILED TO RUN IN THE ELECTION FOR THE TEN BOARD SEATS UP FOR ELECTION AND RESOLVE THAT THE REMAINING TWO 4-YEAR AND THREE 2-YEAR POSITIONS ARE HEREBY DECLARED TO BE VACANT EFFECTIVE THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY, 2015

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Arizona Revised Statute § 15-424A, the Cochise Technology District #01 Board called for an election for ten board seats to be held November 4, 2014; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2014, the date set pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-311B, four candidates have filed for the ten seats up for election on the Cochise Technology District #01 Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 15-424D, in the event that only one person submits a petition for an election to each position on the board of a school district, the Board of Supervisors is authorized to cancel the election and to appoint that person to the district board, subject to not having any write-in candidates prior to August 21, 2014;

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County that the Cochise Technology District #01 Board Election scheduled for November 4, 2014 is hereby canceled.

FURTHER be it resolved that **Clint Sanborn, Rosa Aguallo and Marlene Plumb** who filed to run in the election be hereby appointed to fill **three 4-year positions** and **Mark Goodman, Tara Finch** who filed to run in the election be hereby appointed to fill **two 2-year positions** on the Cochise Technology District #01 Board, with all the powers and duties of that office as if elected to that office, effective the 1st day of January, 2015. and resolve that the remaining two 4-year and three 2-year positions are hereby declared to be vacant effective the first day of January, 2015, to be filled as provided in Section 15-302A(3).
