A RESOLUTION OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS CANCELLING THE SIERRA VISTA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT #68 BOARD ELECTION AND APPOINTING THE TWO CANDIDATES THAT FILED TO RUN IN THE ELECTION TO THE TWO 4-YEAR BOARD SEATS UP FOR ELECTION

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Arizona Revised Statute § 15-424A, the Sierra Vista Unified School District #68 Board called for an election for two 4-year board seats to be held November 4, 2014; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2014, the date set pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-311B, only two candidates have filed for the seats up for election on the Sierra Vista Unified School District #68 Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 15-424D, in the event that only one person submits a petition for an election to each position on the board of a school district, the Board of Supervisors is authorized to cancel the election and to appoint that person to the district board, subject to not having any write-in candidates prior to August 21, 2014;

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County that the Sierra Vista Unified School District #68 Board Election scheduled for November 4, 2014 is hereby canceled.

FURTHER be it resolved that **Marjorie “Marge” Carrithers and Debra Scott** be hereby appointed to fill the two 4-year open board positions on the Sierra Vista Unified School District #68 Board, with all the powers and duties of that office as if elected to that office, effective the 1st day of January, 2015.
