

**RESOLUTION 14-\_\_\_**

**APPOINT THE ELECTION BOARDS FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD  
NOVEMBER 4, 2014**

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of A.R.S. § 16-531 the Cochise County Board of Supervisors shall not less than twenty (20) days prior to a general election appoint for each election precinct one inspector, one marshal, two judges and as many clerks as deemed necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, in Resolution 11-52, the Cochise County Board of Supervisors defined the 49 Election Precincts for Cochise County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors desires that polling places be adequately staffed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors recognizes that circumstances can change quickly, and therefore desires to provide for swift replacement of or additions to members of the election boards.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Cochise county Board of Supervisors hereby appoints the election boards as noted on (Exhibit "A") for the General Election to be held on November 4, 2014

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Elections Director is authorized to make such changes as are necessary to fill vacant positions and to make such changes to the list of approved poll workers as necessary for the conduct of a smooth election process.
