APPOINTING AN ADMINISTRATOR FOR NACO FIRE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the **Naco Fire District** called for an election for three board seats, to be held November 4, 2014; and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2014, the date set pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-311.B, no candidate filed for a seat up for election on the **Naco Fire District** Board; and

WHEREAS, as of December 1, 2014, all three seats on the **Naco Fire District** Board will be vacant;

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 48-803.B, if the governing board members cannot fill their duties, including because they lack enough members for a quorum, the board of supervisors shall appoint an administrator to administer the district with the same duties and obligations of the elected board,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County that **Joe Garcia** is hereby appointed administrator of the **Naco Fire District** Board, with all the
