

RESOLUTION FCD 15-___

SPECIFYING THE RIGHTS-OF-WAY TO BE ACQUIRED FOR THE ASH CANYON CREEK CROSSING PROJECT ON CORONADO MEMORIAL ROAD

WHEREAS, the Flood Control District Board of Cochise County, Arizona is authorized to acquire rights-of-way for and to construct, operate and maintain flood control works and storm drainage facilities pursuant to A.R.S. § 48-3603; and

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2013 the Flood Control District Board of Cochise County, Arizona approved Resolution FCD 13-02 authorizing County participation in the Federal Lands Access Program Grant, hereinafter the "Project", to provide an improved culvert crossing to carry water flows under Coronado Memorial Road to address increased water flows caused by the 2011 Monument Fire; and

WHEREAS, said resolution did not specify the Section, Township, Range or Tax Assessed Parcel Numbers affected by the right-of-way acquisition as needed for title purposes to close escrow and issue title policies to Cochise County; and

WHEREAS, the rights-of-way to be acquired for the Project are within Tax Assessed Parcel Numbers 104-54-010C and 104-54-026B, and are located within the Northwest quarter of Section 3 and the Northeast quarter of Section 4 of Township 24 South, Range 21 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Cochise County, Arizona.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that we, the Flood Control District Board of Cochise County, Arizona, do hereby approve this resolution to identify lands affected by the Project acquisition as needed for title purposes.
