7. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers.

Warrants Nos. 94521-94636, 94638-94668, 94681-94885 were issued in the amount of \$1,109,409.93.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve items 1-7 on the consent agenda. Supervisor English seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

8. Adopt Ordinance 48-15 amending fee schedules to provide for a standardized cost of copying and electronic media for purposes of public records requests.

Mr. Vlahovich noted that after discussion with the County Attorney's Office staff was recommending that the item be tabled to a future meeting.

Chairman Searle noted that there might be members of the audience who attended the meeting to address the Board regarding this item, therefore he would open the public hearing.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing.

Ms. Jan Wilson, County resident, addressed the Board on her concerns over the fees in question and added that she did not agree with the proposed fees because they were

burdensome to the public's right to information.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to table to this item until the January 5, 2016 Regular Board of Supervisors' Meeting. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

ACTION

Board of Supervisors

9. Approve transfer of five acre parcel 408-34-008 on James Ranch Road to the City of Douglas Pursuant to A.R.S. § 42-18303(E).

Ms. Elda Orduno, Civil Deputy County Attorney, presented this item. Ms. Orduno gave the background and said that the reason for the transfer of the parcel is so that the City of Douglas can use it if their proposal for a new port of entry goes through. She cited the statute and said the Board can transfer property directly to another government entity for transportation purposes and this parcel qualifies under that statute for transfer. She noted that a new legal description had been created to split the original parcel in two.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve transfer of five acre parcel 408-34-008 on James Ranch Road to the City of Douglas Pursuant to A.R.S. § 42-18303(E). Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

10. Approve the over-the-counter sales of tax deed properties remaining unsold following the July 2015 online tax deed land auction and subsequent over-the-counter sales, as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, plus related administrative fees.

Ms. Arlethe G. Rios, Clerk of the Board, presented this item. Ms. Rios stated that she had received two bids on four of the parcels remaining unsold. She said that the two OTC bids had been received and were reflected on the attached report; in addition, the bidders would pay a \$75 administrative fee totaling \$4,065 (\$3,915 for bids and \$150 in administrative fees - 2 bidders). The acceptance of these bids brought the total YTD sales to \$106,917.30 and there are 141 parcels remaining for sale.

Supervisor English moved to approve the over-the-counter sales of tax deed properties remaining unsold following the July 2015 online tax deed land auction and subsequent over-the-counter sales, as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, plus related administrative fees. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Facilities Management

11. Ratify professional services from Southwest Hazard Control company for mold abatement at the Douglas Regional Service Center in the amount of \$57,496.60.

Mr. Ruben Miranda, Internal Services Administrator, presented this item. Mr. Miranda gave the background and said that action had to be taken due to personnel safety in the building. He noted that the issue had been addressed, but staff would continue to work on the ventilation issues in the building.

Supervisor English said that the City of Douglas had addressed the sewer smell and noted that the smell was not related to mold.

Vice-Chairman Call asked about the cost to address the ventilation issues.

Mr. Miranda said he would be bringing a formal proposal to the Board.

Mr. Jim Vlahovich, County Administrator, said that staff was working on looking at the building plans to ensure nothing was overlooked at the time the building was finished. He noted that since the cost had been greater than \$50,000 it had to be ratified by the Board since County Administration had given Mr. Miranda permission to address the issue to ensure personnel safety in the building.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to ratify professional services from Southwest Hazard Control company for mold abatement at the Douglas Regional Service Center in the amount of \$57,496.60. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.
