

RESOLUTION 16-__

CANCELING THE DOUGLAS UNIFIED DISTRICT #27 BOARD ELECTION AND APPOINTING THE ONE CANDIDATE THAT FILED TO RUN IN THE ELECTION AND THE ONE CANDIDATE THAT FILED AS A WRITE-IN TO RUN IN THE ELECTION TO TWO 4-YEAR TERM BOARD SEATS OPEN FOR ELECTION AND RESOLVING THAT THE REMAINING ONE 4-YEAR TERM POSITION IS HEREBY DECLARED VACANT

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of A.R.S. § 15-424A, the Douglas Unified District #27 Board called for an election for three 4-year term board seats to be held November 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, only two candidates filed for the three seats up for election on the Douglas Unified District #27 Board pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 16-311 and 16-312; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 15-424D, in the event that only one person submits a petition or nomination paper for an election to each position on the board of a school district, the Board of Supervisors is authorized to cancel the election and to appoint that person to the district board,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Douglas Unified District #27 Board Election scheduled for November 8, 2016 is hereby canceled.

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that **Natalio Sabal** and **Ray Borane** are hereby appointed to fill two 4-year term open board positions on the Douglas Unified District #27 Board, with all the powers and duties of that office as if elected to that office, effective the 1st day of January, 2017; it is further resolved that the remaining one 4-year term open position is hereby declared vacant effective the first day of January, 2017, to be filled as provided in A.R.S. § 15-302A(3).
