

RESOLUTION 16-___

CANCELING THE NACO ELEMENTARY DISTRICT #23 BOARD ELECTION FOR THE ONE 4-YEAR TERM BOARD SEAT UP FOR ELECTION AND RESOLVING THAT THE BOARD POSITION IS HEREBY DECLARED VACANT

WHEREAS, the Naco Elementary District #23 Board called for an election for one board seat, with a four year term, to be held November 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, by the last day set for filing pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-311B, no candidates filed for the one seat up for election on the Naco Elementary District #23 Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 48-1012.E and § 16-410, if no person files a nomination petition for an election to fill a district office, the board may cancel the election for that office and declare it vacant, to be filled otherwise provided by law; and

WHEREAS, as of the last day set pursuant to A.R.S. 16-312.B(2), no candidate filed as a write-in for an election that may be canceled,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Cochise County that the Naco Elementary District #23 Board Election scheduled for November 8, 2016 is hereby canceled.

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board position is hereby declared vacant, effective the 1st day of January, 2017, to be filled as provided in A.R.S. § 15-302A(3).
