

Work Session Request Form

Specific Topic / Wording of Agenda Item: Discussion and possible direction on the request by Army Corps of Engineers for an agreement between Customs and Border Patrol and Cochise County for a real estate right to maintain certain roads in the South King's Ranch road area:

Justification / Executive Summary:

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, acting as the real estate representative for Customs and Border Protection (CBP), will request the County grant to CBP an agreed-upon **real estate right** that will allow CBP to maintain the following roads **at their discretion**. The roads requested will be: S. Kings Ranch Road, E. Lane Ranch Road, S. Hutchinson Road, E. Clinton Road and S. Apache Sky Road, all of which have public right-of-way/easements and are not County Maintained. (added emphasis by Karen Riggs)

Proposed Outcome: Highway and Floodplain recommends that after consultation with CAO on appropriate form of agreement, the Board of Supervisors hold a public hearing on the agreement so residents of the area affected as well as CBP and/or ACOE may speak before the Board. Board can then decide whether to enter an agreement and if so, the agreement form.
