No one else chose to speak and Chairman English closed the call to the public.

10. Approve an award of contract to Thomas C. Holz for Indigent Defense Contract Services pursuant to Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 14-03-IDC-01 for the period of January 7, 2014 through June 30, 2014.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to approve items 1-10 on the consent agenda. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it passed 2-0-1 (Call abstained from item 2).

## **PUBLIC HEARINGS**

### Board of Supervisors

11. Approve an Acquisition of Control liquor license application for a series #6 (bar) liquor license submitted by Mr. Gary J. Cowell for Dillon's located at 6415 E. Hwy 90, Sierra Vista, 85635.

Ms. Arlethe Rios, Clerk of the Board presented this item. Ms. Rios said the Planning and Zoning Department recommended approval, but the Sheriff's Office had no recommendation and the Environmental Health Division noted that the establishment meets all the requirements set forth by the Arizona Food Code; the Treasurer's Office has noted that all property taxes are current. The applicant has paid the \$100 processing fee; the Board staff recommended approval.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Supervisor Call made a motion to approve an acquisition of control liquor license application for a series # 6 (bar) liquor license submitted by Mr. Gary J. Cowell for Dillon's located at 6415 E. Hwy 90, Sierra Vista, 856358. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

## **Community Development**

12. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 14-01 to approve the proposed amendments to the Cochise County Zoning Regulations pertaining to On-Site Agricultural Processing to simplify and clarify the requirements while not altering the intent.

Mr. Rick Corley, Zoning Administrator, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Corley explained the current regulations and explained why the changes were needed. He showed a flow chart of how the current process works, listed the proposed amendments and definitions and stated that staff recommended approval.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to adopt Zoning Ordinance 14-01 to approve the proposed amendments to the Cochise County Zoning Regulations pertaining to On-Site Agricultural Processing to simplify and clarify the requirements while not altering the intent. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried unanimously.

13. Adopt Resolution 14-01 to approve Docket R-14-03, amending the Cochise County Building Safety Code for calculation requirements for Residential Fire Sprinklers and to amend the size of One-story detached accessory structures with no utilities (sheds).

Ms. Beverly Wilson, Planning Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Wilson explained the background. 1st change is regarding fire sprinkler systems for residential dwellings, 2nd change is for sheds. other jurisdictions have adopted newer codes, staff recommends new language be inserted, see slide. shed size exemption, 2 different codes read differently, staff recommends new language, see slide. These changes were approved by the Building code advisory and appeals board.

Chairman English opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman English closed the public hearing.

Supervisor Call moved to adopt Resolution 14-01 to approve Docket R-14-03, amending the Cochise County Building Safety Code for calculation requirements for Residential Fire Sprinklers and to amend the size of One-story detached accessory structures with no utilities (sheds). Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried unanimously.

## **ACTION**

### **Community Development**

14. Adopt Resolution 14-02 authorizing the release of parcel 104-27-200 from the Assurance Agreement of the Rio Corte Subdivision.

Ms. Beverly Wilson, Planning Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Wilson gave the background of the plat and the subdivision and explained that due to foreclosure on the parcel before an assurance agreement was approved there were two owners within one subdivision. She said that the applicant was requesting release so that the parcel's title could be cleared. She noted that the current subdivision was under foreclosure and stated that staff recommended approval.

Vice-Chairman Searle asked if any improvements or amenities had been added since the original plat was approved.

Ms. Wilson confirmed that no additions had been made and that releasing this parcel was the first step in dissolving the original subdivision.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to adopt Resolution 14-02 authorizing the release of parcel 104-27-200 from the Assurance Agreement of the Rio Corte Subdivision. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

15. Adopt Resolution 14-03 to support an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Sierra Vista for funding and construction responsibilities for the Cochise-Vista bicycle path.

Ms. Karen Lambertson, Transportation Planner, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Lambertson said that the bicycle path was 14 miles long and explained that the maintenance by the County would only be done on County portions of the path. She said the agreement would help connect areas that are not contiguous on the bicycle path and the only cost would be for signs as all other work was already part of regular road maintenance.

Mr. John Wettack, Cochise Bicycle Advocates representative, spoke in favor of this agreement on behalf of this group.

Supervisor Call moved to Adopt Resolution 14-03 to support an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Sierra Vista for funding and construction responsibilities for the Cochise-Vista bicycle path. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote and it carried 3-0.

### **County Sheriff**

16. Approve the award Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 14-02-FAC-03 for Inmate Video Visitation/Phone Services to Securus Technology for the period of January 7, 2014 through December 31, 2018.

Dave Seward, Procurement Director, presented this item. Mr. Seward explained that the only change to the contract was adding video visitation services.

Lieutenant Monge said that adding a video visitation service was done in order to eliminate

movement of inmates which caused issues regarding gangs and prohibited contacts as well as determent of contraband and prevention of violent behavior. He noted that every inmate would have access and that attorney's could still visit inmates in person.

The Board agreed that this was a good step for better security at the jail.

Supervisor Call said that there should be some level of flexibility for visitations, but would leave the details up to the Sheriff's Office.

Vice-Chairman Searle moved to approve the award Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 14-02-FAC-03 for Inmate Video Visitation/Phone Services to Securus Technology for the period of January 7, 2014 through December 31, 2018. Supervisor Call seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for vote and it carried 3-0.

17. Approve a Detention Officer Pay Plan to allow base salary adjustments dependent upon certification/training qualifications and tenure requirements.

Mike Ortega, County Administrator, presented this item. Mr. Ortega stated that the detention officer pay plan would adjust salaries for existing staff and start a pay plan similar to the deputy pay plan. He explained that this effort was due to the Board's request to begin salary adjustments and that it would help bring detention officer salaries to market value. He said that the total cost to being the adjustment would be \$260,000 which would come from the jail enhancement fund, but noted that eventually the general fund would be used to cover the plan. Mr. Ortega said that the changes in the budget would be addressed during annual budget meetings and that the pay plan would be effective as of January 5, 2014.

Supervisor Call moved to approve a Detention Officer Pay Plan to allow base salary adjustments dependent upon certification/training qualifications and tenure requirements. Vice-Chairman Searle seconded the motion.

Chairman English called for the vote an it carried 3-0.
