**Housing Authority**

- 9. Ratify Signature and Approve an Amendment between Cochise County and the U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Housing Opportunities for Persons with Aids (HOPWA) grant to carry over approximately \$61,000 from expiring grant #AZH1100018 to renewed grant #AZH140014 for use through January 1, 2018.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve items 1-9 on the consent agenda. Supervisor Searle seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

**PUBLIC HEARINGS**

**Community Development**

- 10. Adopt Resolution 15-05 to adopt the updated Cochise County Comprehensive Plan.

Ms. Beverly Wilson, Planning Director, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Wilson stated that the re-adoption of this plan was required by State statute for the Board to have an official plan as a guide to development in the County. She also listed the steps taken by staff to present the plan to the public and gave some details about the plan and its purpose to guide growth in Cochise County. She stated that the plan was also reviewed by other entities and said that their recommendations and changes were part of the background information previously sent to the Board.

Vice-Chairman English asked about excluding the policies regarding the County's rural character element.

Ms. Wilson said that staff did have concerns about the five policies regarding the rural character element because they include more regulatory language and the plan was crafted to be more of a policy than a regulation.

Chairman Call opened the Public Hearing.

Ms. Anna Lands, Benson resident, stated that the information on the comprehensive plan was not available to public until the day before the meeting and noted several concerns about the plan due to several portions that go beyond policy.

Ms. Arlethe Rios, Clerk of the Board, noted that all attachments had been posted the week prior to the meeting and added that the information had also been available to the public for a year and a half while public meetings were being held, which abided by the Arizona Open Meeting law of posting within 24 hours.

Mr. Wayne Klump, Willcox resident, stated that the plan included many restrictions on private property that he did not agree with.

Mr. Steve Saway, Sierra Vista resident, commended staff for outreach and the Board for holding a public hearing to give citizens a last opportunity to comment and gave the Board a document with his concerns about outdoor recreation, renewable energy element, and policy on wilderness designation.

Ms. Mary McCool, J-6/Mescal Community Development Organization chair, addressed the Board about concerns on certain language in the policy, specifically the rural character intent.

Mr. Peter Moran, St. David resident, addressed the Board on concerns about the County keeping a rural identity.

Ms. Wilson read Sierra Vista resident, Ms. Jere Fredenberg's email stating her concerns on how State and Federal lands should be returned to local governments.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman Call closed the Public Hearing.

Vice-Chairman English stated that the comprehensive plan needed to be a general guideline that is not specific, but gave the public a general idea of what is important to Cochise County.

Supervisor Searle noted that a benefit of having a more detailed plan was so that it can be used when federal plans are made that affect the County. He added that he could not approve the plan as is and recommended some changes.

Mr. Hanson stated that the Board could make changes to the plan, but suggested that the amended document return to the Planning & Zoning Commission for approval before it is approved by the Board.

Supervisor Searle suggested the following changes:

Under Federal Government Coordination Element, Policies, Section "a": add "including the San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area (SPRNCA)"; "c": delete "may" and add "should"/add "all" public lands.

Under Federal Government Coordination Element, subparagraph Other Federal Lands, Goal 3: delete "working with" change back to "requiring".

Under Federal Government Coordination Element, subparagraph Other Federal Lands, Goal 3, Policy a, Wilderness Designations, section iii: delete "superfluous".

Under Federal Government Coordination Element, subparagraph Other Federal Lands, Goal 3, Policy d, Public Access, section iv: change "will" to "should".

Under Federal Government Coordination Element, subparagraph Other Federal Lands, Goal 3, Policy i, Off-Highway Vehicles (OHVs): add a new subparagraph "iv. Federal Travel Management Plans should consider the growing popularity of OHV recreation and provide reasonable and responsible opportunities for OHV uses".

Chairman Call agreed with Supervisor Searle's recommended changes and suggested that the rest of the document be approved, pending approval of the changes by the Planning & Zoning Commission.

Ms. Wilson noted some staff recommendation changes:

Under Rural Character Element, Policies: they agreed to delete sections "c", "d", "e", and "g".

Ms. Lands asked the Board if they would postpone the meeting due to document availability.

Chairman Call stated that the Board is not interested in tabling this item as staff has provided the necessary information throughout the year long-process.

Supervisor Searle moved to adopt Resolution 15-05 to adopt the updated Cochise County Comprehensive Plan with the exclusions and changes noted. Vice-Chairman English seconded the motion.

Chairman Call called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

## **ACTION**

### **Human Resources**

11. Approve the funding for the proposed schedule of benefits and rates adopted by the Cochise Combined Trust for fiscal year 2015-2016.

Vice-Chairman English moved to approve the funding for the proposed schedule of benefits and rates adopted by the Cochise Combined Trust for fiscal year 2015-2016. Supervisor Searle seconded the motion.

Mr. James Vlahovich, Deputy County Administrator, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Mr. Vlahovich reviewed the background information, noted that there was a an increase to the out-of-pocket expenses, that the system would be moving to a fiscal year plan, which would extend the current plan to 18 months, and minor changes to co-pays.

Supervisor Searle asked if the Cochise Combined Trust (CCT) recommended approval of all the changes.

Mr. Vlahovich said that the insurance actuary had recommended the changes and the CCT had approved them at their last meeting.

Vice-Chairman English stated that the trust has been good for Cochise County and its employees and their recommendations have always had a good outcome. She added that staff should be excited about online open enrollment.

Chairman Call noted that continuing to provide this level of health insurance for employees was a financial challenge for the County, which was revisited annually during budget discussions.

Chairman Call called for vote and it was approved 3-0.

## **STATE & FEDERAL LEGISLATION**

12. Discussion and possible action regarding state and federal legislative matters, including but not limited to the items in the attached County Supervisors Association Legislative Policy Committee Agenda and the proposed State budget.

Supervisor Searle noted that Representative David Stevens was supporting bill HB2589, to allow counties to use the Secretary Of State's Office for candidate campaign reporting purposes and wanted Cochise County's support.

Chairman Call asked Supervisor Searle to get more information on costs and update the Board at a future meeting.
