Chairman Searle called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

CONSENT

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of June 14, 2016.

Community Development

2. Adopt Zoning Ordinance 16-03 approving Docket Z-16-01, amending the zoning district designation for parcel 106-15-015C to RU-4 from RU-2 and R-36, pursuant to the request of Mr. John Slaughter.

County Attorney

3. Approve the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission (ACJC) Drug, Gang and Violent Crime Control Grant Agreement DC-17-021 in the amount of \$151,772 between the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission (ACJC) and Cochise County effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.
4. Approve the renewal of Crime Victim Assistance Grant No. VA-16-019, in the amount of \$21,044 between the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission (ACJC) and the Cochise County Attorney's Office effective from July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017.

County Sheriff

5. Approve the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission (ACJC) Drug, Gang and Violent Crime Control Grant Agreement DC-17-003 in the amount of \$124,240 for overtime salaries and fringe benefits (ERE), between the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission (ACJC) and the Cochise County Sheriff's Office, effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.

Health & Social Services

8. Approve IGA ADHS14-053052 Amendment 3 for Women, Infant, Child (WIC) Services, Breastfeeding Peer Counselor Program (BFPC), and the Farmer's Market Nutrition Program (FMNP), between the Arizona Department of Health Services and the Cochise County Health Department in the amount of \$581,930 and \$48,500 respectively, for the period of 10/1/16 – 9/30/17.
9. Approve renewal of Grant Agreement, GRA-STATE-16-0785-01-Y2, Amendment #3, for Child Care Health Consultation, between the Arizona Early Childhood Development and Health Board (First Things First) and Cochise Health & Social Services, in the amount of \$100,020, for the period of 7/1/16 – 6/30/17.

Supervisor English moved to approve items 1-9 on the consent agenda. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Board of Supervisors

10. Approve a new liquor license application for a series #10 (beer & wine store) liquor license submitted by Ms. Pamela Lynn Harper for Fort Willcox RV Park located at 1765 West Fort Willcox Loop, Willcox, AZ 85643.

Ms. Arlethe Rios, Clerk of the Board, presented this item. Ms. Rios said the Sheriff's Office did not have a recommendation and the Planning and Zoning Department had recommended approval. The Environmental Health Division noted that they have no concerns with the issuance of the liquor license; the Treasurer's Office noted that all property taxes are current. The applicant has paid the \$100 processing fee and the Board staff recommended approval.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman Searle closed the public hearing.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve a new liquor license application for a series #10 (beer & wine store) liquor license submitted by Ms. Pamela Lynn Harper for Fort Willcox RV Park located at 1765 West Fort Willcox Loop, Willcox, AZ 85643. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

11. Adopt Resolution 16-18 granting a Telecommunications and Fiber Optic Services franchise to Mobilitie, LLC.

Mr. Hanson, Chief Civil Deputy County Attorney, presented this item. Mr. Hanson gave the background and said that it was a standard franchise agreement and the term was for five years as was typical for these types of franchises. He noted that this company was new to the County and the franchise would apply to the entire County. Staff recommended approval.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing.

No one chose to speak and Chairman Searle closed the public hearing.

Supervisor English moved to adopt Resolution 16-18 granting a Telecommunications and Fiber Optic Services franchise to Mobilitie, LLC. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Community Development

12. Adopt Resolution 16-19 abandoning any interest the County might have in a portion of dedicated public right-of-way known as Friend Drive in Naco.

Ms. Karen Riggs, Highway & Floodplain Director, Community Development Department, presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. Ms. Riggs gave the background, showed a map of the location, and said that the Naco Fire District (NFD) requested the abandonment due to issues of blockage and vandalism of their equipment. She stated that Friend Drive was a non-county maintained road and staff did not foresee the abandonment as an issue. She added that the NFD also requested a waiver of fees for a total of \$4,525.

Supervisor English said that there are utilities under the area, but it can be traveled through, which has been an issue for NFD because they could not back up their trucks to respond to an emergency due to other traffic crowding the area. She said that she was supportive of waiving the fee, but would want a condition of the fee waiver for NFD to build a fence.

Ms. Riggs stated that she had received letters from all the utility companies in support of the

abandonment. She said she had also received a letter from Gay 90s in support and a letter from Copper Glance in opposition, but noted that the access issue had already been resolved through a grant easement.

Chairman Searle asked for staff recommendation.

Ms. Riggs said that staff recommended approval and the fee waiver.

Chairman Searle opened the public hearing.

Mr. Robert Willis, Copper Glance LLC owner, addressed the Board on his concerns with access issues for the back of his business. He said his opposition was due to access to the back of the buildings.

Mr. Joe Garcia, Secretary/Treasurer of Naco Fire Department, addressed the Board and said that Mr. Willis' concerns were being resolved with a grant easement to ensure space for business owners was left to give them access to the back of their properties and added that the fire district would fence the area as there were many issues with graffiti and robberies.

Mr. Willis asked that the easement be a formal, recorded document.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman Searle closed the public hearing.

Supervisor English amended the motion to adopt Resolution 16-19 abandoning any interest the County might have in a portion of dedicated public right-of-way known as Friend Drive in Naco and waive the fees charged in lieu, the fire district would have to build a substantial fence around the property. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Ms. Riggs clarified that an easement was ready for recording that would give the property owners access to the back of their buildings that would extend all the way to Martinez Street.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

ACTION

Community Development

13. Approve Extension of Assurance Agreement for the completion of the Rancho Arizona Subdivision improvements, Docket S-03-02, to July 6, 2019, per the request of developer James W. Sandlin.

Mr. Paul Esparza, Planning Director, Community Development Department, presented this item. Mr. Esparza gave the background and gave a description of the location. He said that the original subdivision was approved by the Board in 2006, but there had been an administrative extension for one year in 2009, then a subsequent three year extension granted by the Board in 2010, then a final three year extension granted by the Board in 2013, which would expire on July 6, 2016. He added that the developer was present to answer questions.

Chairman Searle asked if there were any improvements made.

Mr. Esparza said that there were no improvements in the subdivision and that staff recommended approval as the economy seems to be recovering.

Supervisor English asked if criteria had changed regarding subdivision extensions as the Board has seen more of these lately due to the economic situation.

Mr. Esparza said that there had been changes made to the zoning regulations that affect extension applications.

Vice-Chairman Call asked if there had been any improvements made.

Mr. James W. Sandlin, applicant, explained that he did not think it was practical to do any improvements at this time. He added that there was an existing homeowners association, but he was waiting for the economy to improve. He said that he thought it would benefit the County to extend the agreement for the subdivision and he would be willing to make any changes requested by the County in the future for the subdivision.

Chairman Searle expressed the Board's concern that these subdivisions are still in existence, but not being developed. He asked if this would be a three year extension.

Mr. Sandlin said that it would be for three years and that it would be his last request for an extension.

Vice-Chairman Call requested a work session to discuss assurance agreement criteria to ensure applicants and staff had a clear understanding of the Board's direction.

Supervisor English moved to approve Extension of Assurance Agreement for the completion of the Rancho Arizona Subdivision improvements, Docket S-03-02, to July 6, 2019, per the request of developer James W. Sandlin. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

Procurement

14. Approve an award of contract for Legal Advertising Services to the Arizona Range News as per the responses received for Invitation for Bid (IFB) No. 16-38-PUR-03 for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.

Mr. Terry Hudson, Procurement Director, presented this item. Mr. Hudson gave the background and explained that this process was required by statute and was done on an annual basis.

Supervisor English asked if only one bid had been received.

Mr. Hudson said that two bids were received.

Vice-Chairman Call said that although the cost is a bit higher from the Sierra Vista Herald, their circulation is significantly larger and there is greater transparency to the public and he thought it would be more appropriate to advertise in the Sierra Vista Herald.

Chairman Searle asked what the difference in cost was.

Mr. Hudson said that the bid from the Range News had come in at \$39,000 and the bid from the Sierra Vista Herald had come in at \$60,000.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve an award of contract for Legal Advertising Services to the Arizona Range News as per the responses received for Invitation for Bid (IFB) No. 16-38-PUR-03 for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017., Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Supervisor English requested that the background information be shortened to only show

pertinent information.

Chairman Searle called for vote and it was approved 2-0-1 (Call opposed).
