

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE COCHISE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING HELD ON
Tuesday, August 30, 2016**

A regular board meeting of the Cochise County Board of Supervisors was held on Tuesday, August 30, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room, 1415 Melody Lane, Building G, Bisbee, Arizona.

Chairman Searle called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m.

CONSENT

Chairman Searle moved items 6 and 7 from the Consent Agenda to the Action Agenda.

Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of August 16, 2016.
2. Ratify the signature of Chairman Searle and approve Airport Improvement Plan Grant Offer #3-04-0013-010-2016 from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in the amount of \$77,233 with a local match share of \$3,791 for the Reconstruction of Taxiway 1, Phase 1, Design only at the Bisbee-Douglas International Airport.

Community Development

3. Accept the County Engineer's recommendation to establish Camino de Manana as a declared County Highway and set a Public Hearing for September 27, 2016.
4. Approve demands over six months to Arizona Department of Corrections in the amount of \$12,309.74 for inmate transportation.

County Sheriff

5. Approve an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between Cochise County and the City of Sierra Vista for critical mission use of H5 Production Air Support effective August 30, 2016 to August 30, 2017.
6. Approve Contract Agreement 2016-063 between the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) and the Cochise County Sheriff's Office in the amount of \$1,000,000 from DPS for the construction of the Cochise County Regional Communications Center effective August 30, 2016 to June 30, 2017.

This item was removed from the consent agenda.

Mr. Vlahovich said that he had received questions from Supervisor Call regarding on how this agreement would impact the expenditure limit.

Supervisor English said she needed a better understanding on what the money would be used for specifically and wanted to ensure that the terms of the contract aligned with the purpose the Sheriff had in mind.

Mr. Vlahovich said that he suggested the Board table the item, until further discussions with the Sheriff's Office.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to table the item. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

7. Approve Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) 2016-107 between the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) and the Cochise County Sheriff's Office to hire five new deputies for the Border Strike Force Bureau effective August 30, 2016 to June 30, 2017 with automatic annual renewal options through June 30, 2021.

This item was removed from consent.

Vice-Chairman Call said he had requested to remove this item from the consent agenda to the action agenda due to several issues that were in conflict with the original information given by the Sheriff's Office.

Mr. Vlahovich said that the Chief Deputy Sheriff had indicated that monies were for eight deputies, but only five deputies would be hired and there was also confusion about the length of the contract term from five to ten years.

Vice-Chairman Call said he had several concerns about the funding for this agreement, as well as the specific wording used since it did not state what the Sheriff's Office had originally discussed with the Board. He suggested the item be tabled in order to get more information from the Sheriff's Office.

Supervisor English said she had reservations about this agreement because she could not understand how DPS would provide funding for eight deputies, but we would only hire five and charge for eight. She added that the agreement does not include details about allowing the County to only hire five deputies. She also suggested the item be tabled in order to discuss the details further with the Sheriff's Office.

Chairman Searle said he did not think there was an issue with the agreement and thought that five 5 additional deputies were of value for the County.

Vice-Chairman Call said he was in agreement with the need of more deputies, but needed

clarification on the details of the agreement.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to table the item. Supervisor English seconded the motion.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 2-0-1 (Searle opposed).

County Treasurer

8. Adopt Resolution 16-24 authorizing Cochise County Treasurer to collect and disburse the property taxes for 2016.

Elections & Special Districts

9. Approve six Intergovernmental Agreements (IGA)s between the Cochise County Elections & Special Districts Department and the cities of: Benson, Bisbee, Huachuca City, Sierra Vista, Tombstone, and Willcox for Elections Supplies and Services effective August 1, 2016 through December 31, 2017.

Finance

10. Approve demands and budget amendments for operating transfers. Warrants Nos. 11022-11109, 11119-11260, 111271-11375 were issued in the amount of \$1,397,752.02.

Health & Social Services

11. Approve an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) Contract No. ADHS 13-049245, Amendment #1, County Tuberculosis Control Program between the Arizona Department of Health Services and the Cochise County Health Department for the period of 7/1/2013 to 06/30/2018 in the amount of \$12,000.

Information Technology

12. Approve an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Arizona Board of Regents on behalf of the University of Arizona, Arizona Public Media for the installation of an FM Radio Antenna on a county-owned tower effective from August 30, 2016 through August 30, 2041.

Solid Waste

13. Approve demands over six months to Arizona Department of Corrections in the amount of \$3,361.77 for inmate transportation costs.

Vice-Chairman Call moved to approve items 1-5 and 8-13 on the consent agenda. Supervisor English seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

ACTION

Board of Supervisors

14. Adopt a six-level broad-banded pay structure for Cochise County positions.

Mr. Gilligan presented this item using a PowerPoint presentation. He showed the proposed pay structure, moved on to transition expenses and explained why certain classifications would be addressed more than others. He explained that Band C would be the most impacted and that the funds used for the pay structure were from vacancy savings collected over the last eight years. He clarified that the request from staff today was to have the Board approve only the pay structure, which was the first step in adopting a market based pay plan.

Vice-Chairman Call asked Mr. Gilligan to go over the details of how much each department contributed to the vacancy savings salary pot.

Mr. Gilligan explained that the Sheriff's Office was the one department that had increased its salaries by a large measure and explained that a large portion of that was due to the cost of funding the Public Safety Personnel Retirement System (PSPRS).

Vice-Chairman Call asked about the departments that had their own pay plan.

Mr. Gilligan explained that the Courts, Sheriff's deputies and detention officers had a pay plan, so those employees had been receiving salary increases for the past several years.

Supervisor English said that she was in support of the pay plan and was looking forward on developing a good strategy to implement the pay plan and working with Department Directors and Elected Officials to ensure their employees are getting compensated properly.

Supervisor English moved to adopt a six-level broad-banded pay structure for Cochise County positions. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Vice-Chairman Call said he was in support of the plan, but the challenge was going to be how to fund it.

Chairman Searle called for the vote and it was approved 3-0.

15. Approve the over-the-counter sales of tax deed properties remaining unsold following the May 2016 online tax deed land auction as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, plus related administrative fees.

Chairman Searle said he would recuse himself since his son was the bidder.

Ms. Rios presented this item. She said that there had been two bids received originally, but this morning one of the bidders withdrew his bid. The other bidder had submitted a bid for 42 parcels for \$100 each due to the location and lack of amenities in the area. The total for this OTC would be \$3,375 (\$3,300 for bids and \$75 for the administrative fee. She said that with this sale total year to date sales were at \$200,972.53 and there would be 52 parcels left.

Supervisor English said that the sale was in the best interest of the County as it got those parcels back on the tax rolls.

Supervisor English moved to approve the over-the-counter sales of tax deed properties remaining unsold following the May 2016 online tax deed land auction as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, plus related administrative fees. Vice-Chairman Call seconded the motion.

Vice-Chairman Call called for the vote and it was approved 2-0-1 (Searle recused).

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Chairman Searle opened the call to the public.

Mr. Marvin Bordeaux, Willcox resident, addressed the Board on his concern for the bad condition of the Cochise County Airport. He specifically cited the issue of the taxiway being out of service and not useable and added that this creates a safety and liability issue.

Jack Cook addressed the Board on matters of personal concern.

No one else chose to speak and Chairman Searle closed the call to the public.

This is the time for the public to comment. Members of the Board may not discuss items that are not specifically identified on the agenda.
